ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Abhishek Kumar**, who is in judicial custody since 19.04.2026 in connection with G.B Nagar P.S Case No. 124/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The prosecution story is totally false, concocted and baseless. Ld. Counsel further submits that the real fact is that the informant and petitioner are father and son and due to some family dispute, the case was registered. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.04.2026. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide G.B Nagar P.S Case No. 124/2026 was registered on 10.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 09.03.2026 at about 05 P.M, his son Avinash Kumar, Abhishek Kumar, Saroj Devi started assaulting him. It is alleged that Avhinash Kumar hurled axe on the head of

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informant and Abhishek Kumar assaulted the informant with lathi on his leg.

6. From perusal of the record, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioner that he assaulted in the leg of the informant with lathi and knife. From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that he sustained grievous injury on his head. Moreover, petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.04.2026.

7. As per para-03 of the bail petition as well as para-15 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below.
