This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner **Abhishek Kumar** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Panchrukhi P.S. Case No. 45/2025** registered u/s 304 of BNS. Heard both the side on bail petition.

The Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that no other bail application except this is pending before any other court and it is further submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and the prosecution case is entirely false, fabricated and concocted. The Id. Counsel has further submitted that there is nothing incriminating material has been recovered either from the person or from the conscious possession of petitioner and the petitioner name has been come on the basis of confessional statement of other co-accused and other co-accused have been granted bail and they are enjoying the privilege of bail. It is further stated that petitioner has one criminal antecedent and he is on bail in that case and the petitioner will never abscond or tamper with the **Continued**
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prosecution evidence and he is ready to furnish the bail bond. Accordingly, the ld. Counsel has prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

On the other hand the Ld. APP for state vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. Accordingly, the ld. APP has prayed that the bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner may be rejected.

Heard both the side and perused the case record. From perusal of case record it appears that in this case the FIR has been lodged in connection with **Panchrukhi P.S. Case No. 45/2025** registered u/s 304 of BNS. The prosecution story in brief as per FIR is that on 02.02.2025 at about 05:00 P.M. while the informant was going to collect his wages from his Maalik, Vikas Kumar, near the JSW Cement Office in front of Bhawani Furniture, Tharwara Mor and talking to his Maalik on his mobile phone. At that time, three unknown persons riding on a motorcycle came from behind him and snatched his mobile phone and fled away.

From perusal of case record it appears that the accused petitioner is not named accused of FIR and petitioner's name has come on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused. It further appears that no incriminating material has been recovered from the possession of petitioner and he carries one criminal antecedent in which he is on bail.

Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am inclined to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner **Abhishek Kumar** is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before the ld. Trial Court within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order, the petitioner will be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the

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satisfaction of the Id. Court below subject to the condition as laid down under section 482(2) of the BNSS.
