## **ORDER**

**12.05.2026**

This bail petition has been filed on behalf of custodial-accused namely **Santosh Sah and Suraj Kumar** in connection with G.B. Nagar P.S. Case No. 217/26 registered u/s 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2) of BNS against the petitioners along with others, put up and pressed. The petitioners are in judicial custody since **25.04.2026**.

Heard both sides.

As per the written petition of the informant Arif Ali, the prosecution case, in short, is that on 24.04.2026 at about 8:30 P.M, the informant was play carrom board in front of his house and son of Ashique Ali was also playing there. Further, it is alleged that Raja Kumar was driving bike and he hit the son of Aashique by the bike. Thereafter, Gyashuddin assaulted to Raja Kumar by slap. Thereafter, it is alleged that the family members of Raja Kumar were arrived there and they also assaulted to the informant party by lathi-danda and stoen, which caused injury to the informant on his head and also arsad Alai got injured.

Ld. Counsel of petitioners submits that the petitoners are innocent and have committed no offence rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioners bears clean past having no criminal antecedent. Both sides are pattidars and there is case and counter case in between them. The matter has been compromised between both the parties. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.04.2026. There is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, they pray for anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, Ld. A.P.P opposes prayer of bail.

Having gone through the aforesaid facts and submissions as advanced on behalf of both sides and after perusal of record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2) of BNS against the petitioners along with others. There is allegation against the petitoners of assaulting to the informant's son and Santosh Kumar. There is no injury report on the record. Both sides are pattidars and there is case and counter case in

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between them. Both sides have compromised the case. Informant of G.B. Nagar P.S. Case No. 216/26 and her son (injured) appeared before the court and admitted the factum of compromise by them. There is no criminal antecedent mentioned in the case diary.

So, considering the aforesaid facts, it seems proper to enlarge the petitioners on bail after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court.
