ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Rishdeo Rai@ Rai Vishwa Vijay** apprehending his arrest in connection with Darauli P.S. Case No. 185/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case with an ulterior motive. Learned counsel further submits that no such prayer for either regular or anticipatory bail has been ever filed or pressed on behalf of the petitioner in connection with the instant case either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel further submits that there is land dispute between the parties and there is an inordinate delay of two days in giving information to the police station. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence or the witnesses. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioner may be granted anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R in this case was registered *vide* Darauli P.S Case No. 185/2026 dated 24.04.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 against the petitioner and other unknown accused-persons. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that informant live in Gorakhpur with his family and on 22.04.2026 informant along with his wife had come to his village to collect his share of grains from the share cropper. It is further alleged that his cousin brother Rishdeo Rai had refused to give him his share of grain. On this, he started hurling abuses. When informant refused to abuse him, he attacked the informant on his head, neck and back with an iron rod, due to which

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informant fainted and his gold chain was also snatched by the accused-persons. It is further alleged that there were two-three unknown person with accused who caught hold the informant.

6. From perusal of injury report of informant, it transpires that informant sustained simple injuries caused by hard and blunt substance. From perusal of Para No. 21 of the case diary as well as Para No. 3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears clean criminal antecedent.

7. Considering aforesaid fact, the present anticipatory bail application is **allowed.**

8. It is directed that, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within six weeks from today the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Court below subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of B.N.S.S.
