ORDER

1. Ld. Counsel for the revisionist submits that present criminal revision has been filed assailing the impugned order dated 05.05.2026 wherein while passing the order under section 144 of Cr.P.C, learned S.D.M, Siwan has opined on the title as well as possession over the disputed land, which does not fall within the jurisdiction of learned S.D.M, Siwan in exercise of his power under section 144 of Cr.P.C.
2. Ld. P.P opposes prayer of the revisionist.
3. From perusal of cetified copy of the impugned order filed with this revision petition, this court finds that the learned S.D.M, Siwan erroneously opined on the claim and title of the parties over the disputed land and therefore, he has gone beyond his jurisdiction under section 144 of Cr.P.C. The impugned order passed by the learned S.D.M, Siwan also does not talk about any imminent nuisance or apprehended danger.
4. In view of the above, the impugned order dated 05.05.2026 passed by the learned S.D.M, Siwan in M.No. 1048/2026 is hereby set-aside.
5. Accordingly, present revision petition is disposed of as **allowed**.
6. Office is directed to consign record of this case to the record room after necessar compliance.
