ORDER

09.07.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Samsuddin Ansari @ Rahul**, who is in judicial custody since 20.04.2026 in connection with Darauli P.S. Case No. 174/2026 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 303(2), 317(2), 338 of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. Ld. counsel further submits that nothing incriminating article has been recovered either from the person or possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 20.04.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard, perused record.

5. From perusal of record, it transpires that an FIR Vide- Darauli P.S. Case No. 174/2026 was allegedly instituted on 19.04.2026 for the offences under section 303(2), 317(2), 338 of BNS against the petitioner. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 19.04.2026 at about 11:00 O'clock, the informant was to conduct special raid and at about 14:20 O'clock, he was checking vehicle near Patuwa Nahar Pul Charmuhani and saw that two persons riding on a motorcycle were trying to flee away, seeing the vehicle checking, but they were nabbed with the help of police force. On query, they disclosed their name as Shamsuddin Ansari @ Rahul (petitioner) and the person, who was sitting at rigour seat disclosed his name as Ranjeet Kumar Yadav. On demand of paper, they did not give any paper of motorcycle and

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given satisfactory answer about the motorcycle. On Search, one mobile of Vivo company was recovered from the left pocket of petitioner.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is named accused of the FIR and he was arrested on spot by police. On search, one mobile of Vivo company was recovered from the left pocket of petitioner. Moreover, Investigation has completed against the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 20.04.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-45 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below **with condition that the petitioner shall not repeat such offence in future. If the petitioner is subsequently found indulged in similar offences, the learned trial Court shall take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.**
