ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Suganti Devi@ Rajanti Devi** apprehending her arrest in connection with Mairwa P.S Case No. 444/2025 registered u/s 103(1), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further submitted that earlier no any bail petition either anticipatory or regular on behalf of this petitioner has ever been filed or moved either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has got clean past having no any criminal antecedent. The informant and petitioner both are close pattidar and there is bona fide land dispute between them. Other co-accused of this case has been admitted to bail by the Hon'ble High Court Patna vide Cri. Misc. No. 18901/2026 of Savita Devi and the case of this petitioner sands on same and similar footing. There is no any specific allegation against this petitioner. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence or the witnesses. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR bearing Mairwa P.S Case No. 444/2025 was registered on 03.11.2025 u/s 103(1), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 31.10.2025 at about 1:20 P.M, her pattidar petitioner along with other co-accused persons attacked to her husband Dinanath Chauhan with lathi-danda and iron rod, as the result he became injured and admitted to Siwan Sadar hospital for treatment, from where informant's husband referred to Gorakhpur, but in the way, he succumbed to the injuries.

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6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioners that they along with other co-accused persons assaulted the informant's husband with lathi-danda, iron rod, as the result, he succumbed to the injury. The post-mortem report is available with case diary and from perusal of the post-mortem report of deceased, it appears that the cause of death due to haemorrhage shock due to hard and blunt object. From perusal of statement of witnesses mentioned in para No. 6, 7, 8 of the case diary, it appears that they supported the prosecution version. As per Para No. 13 of the case diary as well as Para No. 3 of bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears clean criminal antecedent.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, present anticipatory bail application is hereby **rejected**.
