ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners moves the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners namely **(1) Jitendra Gond, (2) Guddu Gond** apprehending their arrest in connection with Andar P.S. Case No. 109/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case with an ulterior motive. Learned counsel further submits that never before any bail petition either regular or anticipatory on behalf of the said petitioners have been filed either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna. The petitioners have got clean past. Other co-accused has been already enjoying the privilege of bail by A.B.P No. 803/2026. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence or the witnesses. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R in this case was registered *vide* Andar P.S Case No. 109/2026 dated 20.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 19.03.2026 at around 07:30 P.M, the petitioners along with other co-accused persons came at her house and started hurling abuses and assaulted with fist and slaps and knife. It is further alleged that Raj Kumar and Guddu tore the informant's cloth and started assaulting. When, informant's dewar came for their rescue, Guddu and Jitendra gave knife blow on his neck. Guddu attacked the informant and his father-in-law on their head with knife.

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6. From perusal of injury report, it appears that injured persons sustained simple injury. From perusal of Para No. 31 of the case diary as well as Para No. 3 of bail petition, it appears that petitioners bear clean criminal antecedent. Earlier, co-accused persons have been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 14.05.2026 in AB.P No. 803/2026.

7. Considering aforesaid fact, the present anticipatory bail application is **allowed.**

8. It is directed that, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within six weeks from today the petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Court below subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of B.N.S.S.
