ORDER

This bail petition has been filed on behalf of custodial-accused namely **Bablu Kumar** in connection with Siwan Town P.S. Case No. 957/2025 registered u/s 305, 303(2) of BNS against unknown person, put up and pressed. The petitioner is in judicial custody since **10.04.2026**.

Heard both sides.

As per the written petition of the informant Nand Kishore Tiwari, the prosecution case, in short, is that on 07.12.2025 at about 4:00 P.M, the informant went to market for purchasing vegetables and parked his motorcycle at Shaheed Sarai Market and went for marketing. When, the informant came back at about 4:45 P.M, he noticed that his motorcycle was missing. Hectic search was made, but in vain. The informant is in suspicion that his motorcycle bearing registration no. BR29Z-4842 has been stolen away by some unknown thieves.

Ld. Counsel of petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. There is only one pending case against the petitioner in Gopalganj District vide Excise Case No. 14/26 in which, he is enjoying privilege of bail. On interrogation, 25.100 liter of country made liquor was found in the said motorcycle and not from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is neither owner of the motorcycle nor he has any concern with the said motorycle. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 10.04.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, he prays for bail.

On the other hand, Ld. A.P.P opposes prayer of bail.

Having gone through the aforesaid facts and submissions as advanced on behalf of both sides and after perusal or record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 305, 303(2) of BNS against unknown persons. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R, his name has been surfaced in this case merely on the basis of suspicion. Nothing contrary found against the petitioner either in case diary or Probation Officer's report. The petitioner is languishing in

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judicial custody since 10.04.026. There is only one criminal antecedent of Excise Act against petitioner, appears to be offshoot of this case.

So, considering the aforesaid facts and detention period, it seems proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court.
