**ORDER**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Ankit Kumar**, who is in judicial custody since 12.05.2026 in connection with Goreakothi P.S. Case No. 317/2024 registered under section 309(4) BNS, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity. He further submits that earlier an anticipatory bail application vide A.B.P No. 2712/2025 was filed on behalf of the petitioner before this learned Court and the same has been refused. Being aggrieved went up before Hon'ble Court and filed a Cri. Misc. No. 91287/2025 and the same has been withdrawn thereafter no any bail petition on behalf of the said petitioner has been filed either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble Court. He further submits that earlier a case vide Maharajganj P.S Case No. 96/2025 was lodged against the petitioner in which he is on bail. Co-accused namely Vivek Kumar has been already admitted to bail by this learned Court vide B.P No. 188/2025. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.05.2026. There is no chance of his absconding of tampering with the prosecution evidence. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Goreakothi P.S. Case No. 317/2024 was registered on 18.12.2024 u/s 309(4) of BNS against unknown. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 18.12.2024 when he and his manager Sri Akhilesh Kumar Singh were going to Basantpur market for doing some work. In the meantime, some unknown miscreants snatched the informant's Hero Honda Motorcycle bearing registration no. BR-29-9134 showing pistol and they also snatched the mobile of informant's Manager of Samsung company.

From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name surfaced in this case on the confessional statement of Vivek Kumar leading to recovery of looted mobile containing SIM issued in the name of petitioner. As per Para No. 108 of the case diary as well as Para No. 3 of bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. The petitioner is in custody since 12.05.2026. Moreover, investigation is going on.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and gravity of the offence of broad daylight loot/dacoity, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, therefore the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner **(1) Ankit Kumar** is hereby **rejected.**
