ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Munna Kumar**, who is in judicial custody since 13.03.2026 in connection with Siwan (Town) P.S. Case No. 220/2026 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 303(2) of BNS.

2. Learned counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that no any petition for bail either anticipatory or regular ever has been filed or pressed before this learned Court or any other Superior Court. The petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. Ld. counsel further submits that petitioner is not named in the FIR. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered either from the person or possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR *vide*-Siwan (Town) P.S. Case No. 220/2026 was allegedly instituted on 25.02.2026 for the offences under section 303(2) of BNS against unknown. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that he parked his E-rickshaw bearing registration No. BR29PB0698 near Shahid Lalan Singh Gate of Sadar Hospital, Siwan and went inside the hospital for treatment. When, he came outside the hospital, his E-rickshaw was not there.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is not named in the FIR. No T.I.P has been conducted by police. As per LCR, the investigation of this case is complete and charge-sheet has already been submitted against the petitioner and co-accused u/s 303(2) of BNS. As per Para No. 3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. Earlier, similarly situated co-accused person has been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 01.04.2026 in B.P No. 354/2026. Moreover, petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.03.2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below **with condition that the petitioner shall not repeach such offence in future. If the petitioner is subsequently found indulged in similar offences, the learned trial Court shall take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.**
