ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners namely **(1) Sannu Sah, (2) Rahul Sah**, who are in judicial custody since 21.04.2026 in connection with Siwan (Muffasil) P.S Case No. 223/2026 registered u/s 115(2), 126(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Learned counsel of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel further submits that no prayer for bail on behalf of the petitioners either anticipatory or regular has ever been made either before this learned Court or before Hon'ble High Court at Patna. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is counter case too. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no allegation as alleged in the FIR is made out against the petitioners. Petitioners are in judicial custody since 21.04.2026. There is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Siwan (Muffasil) P.S Case No. 223/2026 was registered on 20.04.2026 u/s 115(2), 126(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 18.04.2026 at about 06:00 P.M (evening), she was searching her Chapal, in the meantime, an altercation was took place due to which the petitioner along with other co-accused assaulted the informant's husband Vijaymal Prasad by means of fists and slaps. When the daughter in law of the informant came to her rescue, Manish Kumar assaulted her by means of brick on her eye.

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6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioners is that they along with other co-accused assaulted the informant and his family members.

7. From perusal of injury report of Minta Kumari, it transpires that she sustained (i) Lacerated wound on left eye 2.5" X ½", (ii) Pain and redness of left eye, which have been opined by the doctor, NCCT of Nose and PNS left side maxillary roof fracture with anterior wall and vision normal, so the injury is grievous in nature caused by hard and blunt object. From perusal of injury report of Kulvanti Devi, it transpires that she sustained (i) Lacerated wound on left hand 1" X ½", (ii) Pain both shoulder, which have been opined by the doctor simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object. From perusal of Para No. 42 of the case diary as well as Para No. 3 of bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears clean criminal antecedent. Moreover, petitioner is in judicial custody since 21.04.2026.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioners are directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below.
