ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners moves the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners namely **(1) Rojddin@ Rojddin Ali, (2) Irfan@ Irfan Ali** apprehending their arrest in connection with Hussainganj P.S. Case No. 193/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case with an ulterior motive. Learned counsel further submits that never before any bail petition either regular or anticipatory bail application on behalf of above named petitioners in the above noted case has been filed either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court at Patna. The petitioners have clean past and they have no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel further submits that petitioners are absolutely innocent, law-abiding citizens, and young students. Learned counsel further submits that the entire dispute has now been completely and amicably resolved between the informant and petitioners. The petitioners and the informant are permanent residents of the same village. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence or the witnesses. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R in this case was registered *vide* Hussainganj P.S Case No. 193/2026 dated 14.05.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 against the petitioners and other co-accused persons. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 13.05.2026 at about 10:00 A.M at Badram Bazar, earlier a dispute broke out between students at a coaching center. It is further alleged that the informant went to Badram Bazar for

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work, whereupon the accused-persons allegedly caught hold of the informant, dragged him to the mosque ground, and assaulted him with lathi-danda and iron pipes and also took away Rs. 2000/- from his pocket.

6. From perusal of injury report of informant Md. Ayub, it transpires that he sustained (i) A cut wound in upper higher region of head size 4 inch skin deep, which has been opined by the doctor as simple in nature. From perusal of Para No. 32 and 33 of the case diary as well as Para No. 3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioners bear clean criminal antecedent.

7. Considering aforesaid fact, the present anticipatory bail application is **allowed.**

8. It is directed that, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within six weeks from today the petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Court below subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of B.N.S.S.
