ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners moves the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners namely **(1) Rinku Tiwari, (2) Abhay Tiwari, (3) Ajay Tiwari** apprehending their arrest in connection with Mairwa P.S Case No. 236/2026 registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are quite innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case due to wrong motive. He has further submitted no bail petition on behalf of the petitioners is filed earlier either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, regular or anticipatory bail save and except this one. Learned counsel further submits that there are three criminal case is pending against the petitioner No.1 Rinku Tiwari, and petitioner No. 2 Abhay Tiwari has no criminal antecedent, and petitioner No. 3 Ajay Tiwari has two criminal antecedent. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence or the witnesses. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently oppose the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R in this case was registered *vide* Mairwa P.S Case No. 236/2026 dated 16.05.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS against accused-petitioners and other co-accused persons. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 16.05.2026 at about 10:00 P.M, informant was going to Siwan market on a motorcycle with his wife Geeta Devi, since his daughter's marriage was fixed and they were going to buy jewellery and clothes. When they reached near the district More Shivalaya, Rinku Tiwari, Abhay Tiwari, Nanhe Tiwari, Ajay Tiwari were already waiting there with iron rods, knife, lathi-danda. It is further alleged that Rinku Tiwari instigated to assault them. On this Abhay Tiwari and Nanhe Tiwari came running and caught hold of his motorcycle and pushed it down, due to which both fell of the motorcycle. It is further alleged that Ajay Tiwari and Nanhe Tiwari attacked the informant with iron rod on his head, but informant stopped it with his hand. It is further alleged that Abhay Tiwari, Nanhe Tiwari, Rinku Tiwari and Ajay Tiwari attacked informant and his wife Geeta Devi with iron

rod and lathi. It is further alleged that Ajay Tiwari attacked on the neck with a knife with intention of killing. It is further alleged that Nanhe Tiwari took Rs. 1,50,000/- from the pocket of informant and Abhay Tiwari snatched gold chain worth Rs. 2,00,000/- from the neck of informant's wife.

6. From perusal of injury report of Geeta Devi, it transpires that she sustained (i) Abrasion on left knee measuring 4cm X 4cm, (ii) Abrasion over left elbow measuring 2cm X 2cm, (3) Abrasion over right elbow measuring 1cm x 1cm, (iv) Abrasion over right side of forehead measuring 1cm X 1cm, (v) Abrasion over left right side of forehead measuring 1cm X 1cm, which have been opined by the doctor injury is simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object.

7. From perusal of para No. 17 of the case diary, it appears that petitioners bear one criminal antecedent. Earlier, co-accused person has been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 16.06.2026 in B.P No. 623/2026.

8. Considering aforesaid fact, the present anticipatory bail application is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within six weeks from today the petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Court below subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of B.N.S.S
