	29.06.2026	1. A regular bail petition dated 10.06.2026 has been filed on behalf of custody accused persons Gulabi Devi, Sindhu Devi, Ramavati Devi who are in custody since 15.06.2026. The copy of which is served upon the ld. P.P. 2. Petitioner has given certificate in para 2 that prior to this bail application no other bail application on behalf of the aforesaid petition either regular or anticipatory has ever been filed either before your honours court or before any superior Court. Petitioner has also stated in para 03 of the bail petition that have got clean antecedent and they have no any criminal history. 3. The prosecution story in nutshell is that on 03.06.2026 at about 11:00 am, while the informant was sitting at the entrance of her house, all the accused persons namely Shivshankar Mahato, Nirmala Devi, Ajit Mahato, Mantu Mahato, Deepmala Devi, Rinki Kumar, Gulabi Devi, Sindhu Devi, Rina Devi, Ramavati Devi, Faujdari Mahato, allegedly armed with an iron rod, lathis and a farsa came there in furtherance of their common intention. It is alleged that they abused the informant, assaulted her, and that petitioner Shivshankar Mahato pulled her by her hair, threw her to the ground, outraged her modesty by removing her saree, and inflicted a farsa blow on her head, causing bleeding injuries. When her relatives intervened to rescue her, they were also assaulted. It is further alleged that the accused persons	04

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	29.06.2026	trespassed into the house, committed theft of cash of Rs. 20,000 and a gold chain worth about Rs. 40,000 and vandalized household articles. 4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioners and informant are pattidar and a land dispute between the parties. That all the sections applied in this case are bailable in nature except 109 BNS, which is not made out against these petitioners. That the petitioners are ladies. That this case is counter version of Aandar P.S. Case No. 188/2026 and this case co-accused of this case Shiv Shankar Mahato lodged the first information report against the informant and her family members of this case. That no specific allegation against the petitioners and his family members to assault the informant. That the petitioner undertake to remain physically present on each and every date whenever required by the learned court. That the petitioners are ready to furnish their bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Court. It is therefore prayed that your honour may graciously be pleased to allow this petition, and for this the petitioners shall ever pray. 5. Ld. APP has opposed the prayer for bail. 6. Heard. Perused the case diary, copy of injury report has been submitted by the Ld. APP and the same is simple in nature. The petitioners are women. There are general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. The petitioners are further ready to abide by all the terms and conditions that may be imposed for grant of regular bail. 7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the incarceration period and the fact that petitioners are women, I am inclined to allow this regular bail petition. Consequently, accused petitioners Gulabi Devi, Sindhu Devi, Ramavati Devi are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each and subject to conditions as mentioned in Section 437 (3) Cr.P.C./ 480 BNSS to the satisfaction of the Court below. 8. Accordingly, the bail petition filed on behalf of custody accused
