This anticipatory bail petition dated 10.06.2026 filed on behalf of the accused petitioners (1) Satyaprakash Prasad, (2), Jaimala Devi, (3) Binda Devi, (4) Nisha Devi, (5) Bipin Kumar in connection with Police Station – Daraundha P.S. Case No. 227/2026 Under Section- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 74, 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5). the copy of which is served upon the ld. P.P 2. Petitioner has given certificate in para 2 of the bail application that no bail petition either regular or anticipatory on behalf of the petitioners has ever been filed either in your honours court or any higher Court. Petitioners has also stated in para 3 of the bail petition that have got clean past having no criminal history. 3. The prosecution story in nutshell is that on 26.05.2026 at about 3:00 pm while the informant's son Amit Kumar was conducting coaching classes in rented premises. The accused persons objected to the coaching classes, abuse him and demanded that he vacate the premises. Despite the land lord informing them that the premises had been lawfully rented out, the accused persons allegedly formed an unlawful assembly, criminally trespassed into the coaching centre and assaulted Amit Kumar with sticks and iron rod, causing injury. When the informant Ramavati Devi along with her daughter Arti Devi and son Pradeep Kumar intervened to rescue him, they were also

	03.07.2026	assaulted. It is alleged that Vipin Kumar struck the informant on the head with an iron rod, causing a serious head injury. The accused further allegedly assaulted Arti Devi tore her blouse and saree with the intention of outraging her modesty, and cause injuries to her with an axe. When a coaching student Praveen Kumar intervened he too was assaulted by the female accused persons. The accused also allegedly extended threats to kill the informant and her family. 4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that all sections applied are bailable and so far section 74 is concerned is not probable in so called scuffle where there were altogether six accused persons male and female inmates of the family and if the petitioners had any intention to commit the murder there was not any intervening circumstances to prevent them only the free fighting had been made and both the parties have sustained injury. That the petitioners are ready to furnish their bail bond to the satisfaction of the court and abide by the conditions u/s 482(2) BNSS. That the petitioners are ready to furnish their bail bond. It is therefore, prayed that your honour be pleased to kindly enlarged the petitioner on bail. And for which the petitioners shall ever pray. 5. Ld. APP has vehemently opposed this anticipatory bail petition. 6. Heard. Perused the case diary. I.O. has submitted the injury reports. Although, injuries of other injured persons are simple in nature. However, injury on the injured Praveen Kumar has been kept reserved. The nature of injury is indicated in the injury detail and which is a cut wound with three stitches on left side of parietal region. Investigation is still in progress. The allegation that the petitioner Sunil Kumar had allegedly played a dangerous role in the occurrence. The injury on the injured Praveen Kumar is yet to be submitted. 7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the fact that investigation is still in progress, at this stage, I'm not inclined to allow this
