ORDER

14.07.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Kavita Kumari**, who is in judicial custody since 14.05.2026 in connection with Bhagwanpur Hat P.S. Case No. 198/2026 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 80(2), 3(5) of B.N.S against the petitioner.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. The allegation as alleged against the petitioner is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. counsel further submits that petitioner was not present at the time of occurrence. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.05.2026. There is no chance of her absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard, perused record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Bhagwanpur Hat P.S Case No. 198/2026 was registered on 11.05.2026 u/s 80(2), 3(5) of B.N.S against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that the marriage of his daughter was solemnized on 24.11.2024 with Lav Pandey according to Hindu rites and rituals, thereafter all the accused persons tortured her for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry. On 10.05.2026 at about 11:45 P.M, informant received a call that her daughter is no more. When, the informant reached at Mundipur, he saw that his daughter has died and found injury mark on her neck.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is named accused of the FIR. The photo copy of post-mortem report is available with the case

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diary. From perusal of the post-mortem report, it appears that on external examination (i) bruise mark below left side mandible of 3"x 1/1/2", (ii) Bruise mark back of upper of left neck of size 4"x 1/2" and doctor opined the cause of death was Asphyxia due to above mention injury by strangulation. Thus, the injury appears to be in tandem with the allegation and it also appears that daughter of the informant died in unnatural circumstances within one and half year of her marriage and there is allegation of demand of dowry by petitioner and other co-accused persons. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.05.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-21 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid fact and gravity of the offence and the fact that investigation is still pending, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail, therefore the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Kavita Kumari** is hereby **rejected**.
