**Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 1609/2026**

**ORDER**

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Ajay Kumar Yadav, (2) Vishwajit Singh**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Daraundha P.S. Case No. 185/2026 registered u/s 25(1-b)a, 26/35 Arms Act, 310(4), 310(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered either from the person or possession of the petitioners. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Daraunda P.S. Case No. 185/2026 was allegedly instituted on 28.04.2026 for the offences under section 310(4), 310(5) of BNS & 25(1-b)(a), 26, 35 of Arms Act against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that upon secret information about assembly of some boys of bad antecedent in Madarichak orchard, it was raided and three persons were nabbed with the help of police force and two fled away. On query, they disclosed their name as Vikki Yadav, Mohit Yadav and Shivam Kumar Sah and also disclosed the name of fleeing persons as Ajay Kumar Yadav and Vishawajeet Singh both resident of village Madarichak. On search of body of nabbed accused persons, one country made pistol and one live cartridge was recovered from the possession of Vikki Yadav. One live cartridge was recovered from right pocket of Mohit Yadav. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of Shivam Kumar Sah.

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6. From perusal of FIR, it appears that petitioners were not nabbed on spot and their name has been transpired in this case on the confessional statement of Vikki Yadav, Mohit Yadav and Shivam Kumar Sah.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-18 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that petitioners have clean antecedent, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS **with condition that the petitioners shall not repeat such offence in future. If the petitioners are subsequently found indulged in similar offences, the learned trial Court shall take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.**
