ORDER

21.07.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Arjun Gond @ Arjun Kumar Gond, (2) Dinesh Gond @ Dinesh Sah, (3) Vidyawati Devi @ Vidhanti Devi**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Nautan P.S. Case No. 06/2024 registered u/s 147, 148, 323, 354B, 379, 307, 511 of IPC.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that no such type of occurrence has ever taken place. Petitioners and the prosecution party are the next door neighbours. There is counter case too. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R *vide* Nautan P.S. Case No. 06/2024 was registered on 08.01.2024 on the basis of C. Case No. 1274/2023 u/s 147, 148, 323, 354B, 379, 307, 511 of IPC against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per complaint petition, the complainant alleged that on 09.06.2023 at about 06:30 o'clock, she was cooking food in her house, in the meantime complainant's goat went to the field of complainant, thereafter all the accused persons came at the Darwaja of the informant and started hurling abuses and assaulted the complainant with lathi-danda and leg.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. Moreover, similarly situated other co-accused persons have been admitted to bail by Ld. predecessor of this court vide order dated 19.03.2024 in A.B.P No. 342/2024

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7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-65 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
