	11.08.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition dated 02.07.2026 filed on behalf of the accused Gaurav Nath Tiwari @ Golu Tiwari in connection with– Guthani P.S. Case No. 106 /2026 u/s - 25(1-B)(a), 26, 35 Arms Act. The copy of which is served upon the ld. P.P. 2. Petitioner has given certificate in para 2 of the bail application that earlier no any bail petition on behalf of above named petitioner, either regular or anticipatory has been filed either before your honour or before Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna. Petitioners has also stated in para 3 of the bail petition that as per the information which the petitioner has, he is bearing following antecedents of criminal nature- (I) Guthani 257/2021, (ii) Guthani 260/2021, (iii) Guthani 261/2021, (iv) Guthani 4/2023, (v) Guthani 5/2023, (vi) Guthani 90/2026, (vii) Guthani 30/2021, (viii) Guthani 104/2018, (ix) Guthani 92/2026. 3. The prosecution story in nutshell is that on 19.03.2026 on the basis of secret information and technical evidence in Guthani P.S. Case No. 92/2026 the police party proceeded for a special raid. At Revasi Tiraha during vehicle checking the accused Deepak Singh was allegedly apprehended while attempting to flee on seeing the police. On his personal search one country-made pistol, having a barrel length of about 7 inches and	

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	11.08.2026	butt length of about 4 inches, with wooden grips on both sides painted red, along with two live cartridges bearing the marking KF-12 was recovered from his possession. The accused failed to produce any valid document or licence regarding the firearm and ammunition. During interrogation, he allegedly disclosed that he was working as a lineman for co-accused Golu Tiwari and had provided information to him regarding the injured Sunil Singh in connection with the said case through his mobile phone. He further allegedly disclosed that the country-made pistol and cartridges had been given to him by Golu Tiwari for keeping in his possession. The recovered firearm and cartridges were accordingly seized through a seizure list. 4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is totally innocent and has been falsely been implicated in this case just because he is a staunch supporter of a prospective candidate of Zila panchayat election to be held this year. That the petitioner is highly reputed businessman of locality and police is trying to apprehend him only to harass him. If he is arrested his image would be tarnished very badly. That the petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond and also to fulfil such condition as to the satisfaction of your. That the petitioner undertakes not to temper the prosecution evidence and to cooperate into the investigation. It is therefore, prayed that your honour be pleased to kindly enlarged the petitioner on bail. And for which the petitioners shall ever pray. 5. Ld. APP has vehemently opposed this anticipatory bail petition. 6. Heard. Perused the TCR and the case diary. It appears that although charge-sheet has been submitted against the custody accused Deepak Singh, however, further investigation is still pending against the petitioner and others. In Para 14 of the supplementary case diary, 05 criminal history of the petitioner has been mentioned and all of them are related to Arms Act and other I.P.C. offences. 7. Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances and the criminal	
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11.08.2026	antecedent of the petitioner and the accusation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to allow this Anticipatory Bail Petition. Accordingly, the bail petition dated 02.07.2026 filed on behalf of accused Gaurav Nath Tiwari @ Golu Tiwari is hereby rejected. 8. Any observation made herein above is not an opinion on the merits and the same is only for the purpose of the instant bail petition. 9. Trial Court record be returned forthwith.
