Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 27/2026

ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely **Jubair Ansari** in apprehending his arrest in connection with Daraundha P.S. Case No. 456/2025 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 132, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner and others, put up and pressed.

As per the computerized petition of the informant under government scheme, the work has been assigned to the National Adanai Energy Solutions Ltd for installing smart meters. It is alleged that on 13.09.2025, the employees of the Electric Department went for installing smart meters of consumer no. 12740013197 and consumer no. 127402007345, then petitioner and other did not allow them to install the smart meters and they also abused and assaulted to the employees of electric department and threatened to the said employees of dire consequences. It is further alleged that accused persons made rumour for not installing the smart meters among other consumers.

Ld. Counsel of petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner bears clean past having no criminal antecedent. No offence alleged has been taken place at the spot with the petitioner. All sections areailable except section 132 of BNS, which is not applicable against the petitioner as no information was given to the petitioner from the said department for installing smart meters. In the meantime, the petitioner is in apprehension of his arrest by the hands of local police. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, he prays for anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, Ld. A.P.P opposes prayer of anticipatory bail.

Having gone through the aforesaid facts and submissions as advanced on behalf of both sides and after perusal of record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 132, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner and others. The allegation against the petitioner is that he forbade to electric department's employees for installing the smart meters as well

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as assaulted to them while giving abusing. There is no independent witness in the case diary. Allegation against petitioner is general and omnibus. The petitioner bears no criminal antecedents as mentioned in para no. 3 of the bail petition.

So, considering the aforesaid facts, it seems proper to grant privilege of bail to the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within four weeks from today after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court subject to condition as mentioned u/s 482 of BNSS **with further condition that (1) one of bailor shall be local representative as mukhiya, sarpanch and ward member and (2) if found involved in another case of similar nature, bail bonds of the petitioner shall be liable to be cancelled.**
