Present: Learned counsel for the revisionists.

1. Ld. Counsel for the revisionists submits that the present revision petition has been filed assailing impugned order dated 08.10.2025 passed by S.D.M, Maharajganj under section 144 of Cr.P.C.(Section 163 of BNSS). Ld. Counsel further submits that while deciding an application under 144 of Cr.P.C, learned S.D.M, Maharajganj erred by giving his opinion on title of land in dispute, which is beyond the competence of an executive magistrate in exercise of his jurisdiction under section 144 of Cr.P.C. Ld. Counsel also fairly submits that the order has become infructuous because two months has already lapsed after passing of this order.
2. Ld. P.P opposes prayer of the revisionists.
3. Heard and perused the record.

From perusal of the certified copy of the impugned order filed with this revision application, this court finds that the impugned order dated 08.10.2025 has already lost its enforceability and the same is no longer binding upon any of the parties as the same has been become infructuous by efflux of time. Therefore, the present revision petition is **disposed of as infructuous.**
