1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Sajan**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Mairwa P.S. Case No. 495/2025 registered u/s 317(2) of BNS along with 11(k)(kh)(g)(gh) Animal Cruelty Act.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that petitioner is the owner & driver of the goods carrier vehicle bearing registration no. NLO1AG8733. Ld. Counsel further submits that the petitioner carry the bonafide article in his bonafide vehicle, but due to accident of the vehicle, the entire occurrence took place. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R *vide* Mairwa P.S. Case No. 495/2025 was registered on 06.12.2025 u/s 317(2) of BNS along with 11(k)(kh)(g)(gh) Animal Cruelty Act against unknown. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 05.12.2025 at about 22 o'clock, he was in night patrolling duty. During patrolling duty, on 06.12.2025 at about 03:10 o'clock, informant found an information that one container bearing registration no. NL01AG8733 is coming towards village-Kaithauli. On information, informant reached at spot and found that the said container is went in a ditch of the road, which causes the traffic problem. Thereafter crane called upon and after that the container was carried out. Thereafter, crane was searched and it was found that altogether 32 animals were dead.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is not named in the FIR, but from perusal of para-36 of the case diary, it appears that petitioner is the owner of the seized container *vide* registration no. NL01AG-8733.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed.**

9. It is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
