24.03.2025 The bail petition of the custody accused petitioner namely Chandan Kumar has been pressed today. The petitioner has surrendered before this court on 22.03.2025 and since then he is in judicial custody

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner Chandan Kumar surrendered before this court on 22.03.2025 and hence prayed for regular bail. The learned counsel further submits that the bail bond of petitioner was got cancelled for his non-appearance vide order dated 09.11.2022 and consequent thereupon the process of non bailable warrant of arrest was issued against him. It is submitted that no delay or latch has been committed by petitioner deliberately and the default so made in compliance of the conditions of bail bond was inadvertent. It is further submitted that petitioner undertakes to remain present physically before court as and when required into the matter. The learned counsel prays to release the petitioner on bail.

The learned Special Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer of learned counsel of petitioner.

Heard the parties and perused the record. On the perusal of record it transpires that the bail bond of petitioner was got cancelled vide order dated 09.11.2022 and subsequent thereto the

process of non-bailable warrant of arrest against him was issued by this court. The petitioner has surrendered before this court on 20.03.2025. From the perusal of record it transpires that petitioner was admitted to bail by this court earlier and due to default as alleged to have been made, resulted into cancellation of his bail bond. It has been submitted that the default was not made deliberately and it has been undertaken that petitioner will remain physically present as and when required by this court. It is, therefore, ordered that upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of the like amount the petitioner be admitted to regular bail. It is further directed that (a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial court.

(d) The petitioner shall adequately represented till disposal and physically present till charge framing.
