This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 7.5.2026 in connection with Chandradeep P.S.Case No.83/2026 registered for the offence U/s.115(2), 126(2), 329(4), 109, 74, 351(2) and 352 read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of A.C.J.M.1st,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Makeswar Prasad Yadav,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Sarojni Devi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Chandradeep Police Station alleging therein that on 5.5.2026 when she was at her home alongwith her child, then all of sudden, two persons entered into her house and started abusing her daughter namely Nisha Kumari and also assaulted her by means of iron rod, consequently she got injury on her head and thereafter she was treated in Health Center Aliganj. The informant stated the name of the culprits as Kaushal Yadav and Khushbu Devi.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has clean antecedent,and both the parties have entered in an amicable settlement by way of a written compromise,and pursuant thereof, the informant has appeared and does not oppose the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail but conceded the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact both the parties have entered into an amicable settlement and informant has appeared before this court and does not

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oppose the prayer for bail of the petitioner and also supported the factum
compromise between them.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released
on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below **subject to the
conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioner must be his close relative,
and petitioner shall remain present before the court below on each and
every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent
reason shall result in cancellation of his bail bonds.**
