In view of clauses 21 & 22 of the Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (Fifth Amendment) Rules, 2022, the DAR is treated as claim petition u/s 166, Motor Vehicles Act 1988. Memo of parties be filed by the petitioner on or before the NDOH.

The petitioner may file statement of facts in the prescribed Form G, Delhi MACT Rules, 2008 within next 14 working days from today with advance copy to opposite party.

The petitioner is directed to open a bank account in a nationalized bank near his place of residence and to place on record the

photocopy of his passbook on the NDOH. The concerned bank is also directed not to issue any cheque book or debit card/ATM etc. and to make an endorsement in this regard on the passbook of the petitioner itself. A copy of this order be given dasti to the petitioner to submit the same before the concerned bank.

Since the insurance company has put in its appearance today, it is directed to examine DAR and file an appropriate response in the prescribed Form XI, in terms of the points 26 of Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (Fifth Amendment) Rules, 2022 in this Tribunal within 30 days with advance copy to the petitioner. Respondent No. 2/ Insurance Company shall also furnish its complete bank details in the written statement. In case of default/delay in filing of the said response, appropriate costs shall be imposed upon the insurance company.

Written statement, if any, be filed by the respondents within 30 days from today with an advance copy to the opposite side.

Put up completion of pleadings/ further proceedings on **25.03.2026.**
