Order

1. The anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners-(1) **Karun Patel**, (2) **Lagan Paswan**, (3) **Pramod Paswan @ Pramod Kumar Paswan**, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with aforesaid case, **Mahnar P.S. Case No. 381/2019**, U/s – 341, 323, 324, 308, 379, 504/34 of I.P.C.

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner pressed the anticipatory bail petition and submitted that it is first application for anticipatory bail for & on behalf of petitioners before your honour in connection with aforementioned case and earlier in this matter they have neither moved for anticipatory nor for regular bail either before your honour or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court nor such application either under section 482 of B.N.S.S. on their behalf is pending anywhere. That petitioners bear clean antecedent. That petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. That no such occurrence as narrated in the instant F.I.R. did ever take place, but petitioners have falsely been booked in this case just in order to save own skin from Mahnar P.S. Case No. 382/2019 lodged by petitioner Lagan Paswan against the present

That in fact on 05.11.19 the present informant and others forming an unlawful assembly assaulted petitioner Lagan Paswan and others causing grievous injury, and publically abusing him that is why information to police Mahnar P.S. Case No. 382/2019 of SC/ST Act was registered against the present informant and others. That, it is submitted that the injuries sustained by the informant & his son are simple in nature. That, it is pertinent to submit her that there was free fight between both the parties and both sides sustained injury. That it is submitted here that both the parties are co-villagers. That, in fact entire case of prosecution is quite false and vexatious one having no resemblance with iota of truth. That, in view of the facts stated above, custodial interrogation of petitioners is not essential. That petitioners undertake neither to abscond nor to tamper with prosecution evidence and they are ready to co-operate with investigation and trial. That petitioners are ready to abide by the conditions imposed upon them. That petitioners are also ready to furnish bail bond of satisfactory amount. 3. Per contra, Ld. A.P.P. opposed prayer for regular bail and submitted that the the cognizance of the offence has been taken by Ld. J.M. 1st class. 4. As per written application of Informant-Amrendra Prasad Yadav, the prosecution's case in short is that on 05.11.2019 about 07:45 am., when informant was near his cow in the morning, Karun Patel, Murli Patel and Lagan Paswan came to him in a pre-planned manner and while talking, suddenly assaulted him with lathi and bamboo sticks. Before he could understand anything, his head was badly injured. When informant's son Vishal came to rescue him, Pramod Paswan attacked him, due to which Vishal's finger got injured. Karun Patel along with his other associates chased and assaulted them with lathi, spear and sword, and snatched away a gold chain weighing about 10 gms from his neck. The entire
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19.05.2026	occurrence was allegedly planned by Don Singh, who directed his men to execute the attack. Prior to his incident also, written information regarding apprehension of such occurrence had been submitted to the S.H.O. Mahnar, and other senior officials. 5. Heard both sides, and perused the L.C.R., available C.D. In C.D. Para-44 supplementary injury report of Amrendra Prasad Yadav and Vishal Kishore are mentioned, according to this report the nature of injuries of both injured persons are simple in nature. cognizance of the offence has been taken by Ld. J.M. 1st Class vide order dt. 01.02.2023. As per bail petition para-3 they have no criminal antecedent. 6. Hence, regard being had to above mentioned facts and circumstances, application for anticipatory bail of the above mentioned petitioners are allowed and I direct that, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within fifteen days (15 days) from the date of receipt of copy of this order, petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing their bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld Court below subject to the condition under the provision of Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. 7.
