ORDER

1. Common order has been passed for both the anticipatory bail applications as they are arising out of same **P.S. (Tisiauta) P.S. Case No. 183/2025, U/ss – 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.**

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioners pressed anticipatory bail petitions and submitted that the petitioners have not earlier moved either regular or anticipatory bail petition before

<p>23.03.2026</p>	<p>this Ld. Court or before the Hon'ble High Court of judicature at Patna. That the petitioners in A.B.P. No. 3230/25 have one criminal bad antecedent, in which they are on bail. In A.B.P. No. 348/26, petitioner has three criminal antecedents, in which he is on bail. That the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no any offence. That all the allegations are false, fabricated concocted and baseless one. That, the petitioners were not involved directly or indirectly in alleged occurrence. That, the petitioner's Atul Kumar @ Deepak Sah has lodged criminal case against the informant of this present caes and his family member vide Mahua P.S. Case No. 1076/2025, U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 324(4), 308(3), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. 2023, and due to this reason, informant has lodged this false and fabricated case. That, the informant and other persons were try to capture the petitioner's land vide Khata No. 17, Khesra No. 247, Area 59 Decs which land registered in the name of petitioner's father Ramnath Sah. That, a Titile Suit bearing no. 733/2025 is pending before this civil court Vaishali for the purpose of said land. That, no allegation against the petitioners for assault so far allegation of snatch in which allegation are super addition. That, the petitioners are ready to abide by all ther terms and condition as laid down under section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S. 2023 if any. That, the petitioners will not abscond nor tamper with the prosecution evidence. That the petitioners are further ready to furnish sound bail bond of local bailors to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court.</p> <p>3. The Ld. A.P.P. vehemently opposed the anticiatory bail applications, and submitted that the petitioners are named in the FIR, and further investigation is still going on.</p>

4. On the basis of fard-bayan of Informant-**Vijay Rai**, the prosecution's case in short is that on 09.11.25, about 02:00 pm in day, informant has gone from his house to Lakshmi Narayanpur playground to buy a cow from Mukhlal Mahto. Mukhlal Mahto was living on government land by making his hut of tripal, informant went to the same place to buy cow from Mukhlal Mahto, when suddenly (1) Deepak Sah, (2) Alok Sah, (3) Anil Sah @ Bithal Sah, and 10-12 unknown people reached there with sharp weapons and started getting Mukhlal Mahto's hut and the government playground in which there was a Volleyball ground ploughed by the said people with a tractor and started breaking the ground, when Informant objected and said that it is a government playground, why are you breaking it, and ploughed it. On this Deepak Sah attacked on him with axe but he moved away from there and saved himself, then again Deepak Sah hit him on the head with an axe due to which informant head got cracked and a lot of blood started flowing, he fell on the ground, then Anil Sah took out Rs. 50,000/- from his pocket, which he had taken to buy a cow, after that Alok Sah started hitting him on the chest with an iron rod, hearing the noise villagers nearby started gathering and seeing the villagers, all the above mentioned persons ran away. By the help of villagers taken to Mahua Hospital for treatment, later referred to Sadar Hospital Hajipur for better treatment.

5. Heard, both sides and perused the C.D., the supplementary injury report is separately attached with C.D., according to this report, the nature of injury is simple in nature.

6. Hence, regard being had to above mentioned facts and circumstances, applications for anticipatory bail of the above

Court below within fifteen days (15 days) from the date of receipt of copy of this order, petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing their bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two surities of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld Court below subject to the condition under the provision of Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.</p> <p>7.
