The petitioner above named is in custody since 06.02.2026 in connection with Rajapakar PS Case no. 441/2025, u/s 80, 3(5) of BNS Act, and hence instant petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on his behalf.

Heard the learned lawyer for the accused/petitioner as well as Learned APP on behalf of state.

The prosecution case in short is that Nitu Kumari is the informant of this case. It is alleged in her written application that her sister marriage was solemnized with Anish Kumar Patel in accordance with hindu rites and rituals on 28.11.2023. At the time of marriage Rs. 3, 50,000/- cash was given to the father of Anish Kumar Patel for Jewellery, furniture etc purchasing. After marriage she went to her sasural where her husband along with her father-in-law namely Ranjeet Patel, mother-in-law Putul Devi and her sister-in-law namely Minu Kumari started demanding motorcycle in dowry and due to non fulfillment of the same they assaulted and tortured her. The further prosecution case is that on 28.11.2025 she received information that all the above named accused persons committing the murder of her sister. Accordingly, with the said

allegation FIR has been instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that allegation as alleged in the FIR is totally false and concocted. It is further submitted that petitioner is husband of deceased. It is further submitted that petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties and are also ready to abide the conditions as laid down. It is therefore prayed that petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ld. APP opposed the petition and submitted that this is the case of murder and the petitioner is husband of deceased and there is specific allegation against him of torturing the deceased in demand of dowry and due to non-fulfillment of the same committed her murder. Hence his regular bail application is fit to be rejected.

From perusal of LCR and case diary it transpires that petitioner is husband of sister of informant and there is specific allegation against him of torturing the sister of informant in demand of dowry and due to non fulfillment of the same committed her murder with the help of other co-accused persons. The informant in his re-statement in para 4 and other witnesses in para 5, 6, 16, 44 of the case diary have supported the prosecution case. The post mortem report of deceased is mentioned in para 35 of the case diary wherein the doctor has found the case of death is due to Asphyxia due to hanging.

In the above facts, circumstances and also considering the fact that the marriage took place on 28.11.2023 and the occurrence took place in the year 2025 within seven years of marriage. The accused/petitioner is husband of the deceased and there is allegation that after marriage the accused/petitioner started demanding motorcycle and for non fulfilment of demand of dowry committed death of informant's sister. marriage was performed 2 years ago of the alleged incident within seven years of marriage and soon before her death there was demand for dowry. The allegation against accused/petitioner is heinous in nature. Hence I am of the opinion that it is not a fit case to admit the accused/petitioner to regular bail, hence his regular bail application is hereby rejected.
