The petitioner above named is in custody since 29.02.2026 in connection with Lalganj PS Case no. 370/2025, u/s 329(4), 64, 308, 3(5) of BNS and hence instant petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on his behalf.

Heard the learned lawyer for the accused/petitioner as well as Learned APP on behalf of state.

The prosecution case in short is that one Vicky Kumar was establishing physical relationship with the informant while she was minor on the false promise of marriage. It is alleged that on 17.07.2025 Vicky Kumar along with his three friends namely Rahul Kumar, Sunny Kumar and Niraj Kumar arrived at her house when her parents were not at home and Vicky Kumar established physical relationship with her whereas his other associates made video of the act. It is further alleged that petitioner and others have made threatening call to the mother of informant and also demanded Rs. 2 Lakh and Vicky Kumar further refused to do marriage with informant. Accordingly, with the said allegation FIR has been

instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely implicated in this case due to village politics. It is further submitted that entire prosecution version as alleged is maliciously false and concocted. It is at last submitted that petitioner is ready to furnish sound and suitable sureties to the satisfaction of the court. It is therefore prayed that petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ld. APP opposed the petition and submitted that the petitioner is named accused in the FIR and there is specific allegation against him of establishing physical relationship with informant on the pretext of marriage and made her video with the help of his associates. Hence his regular bail application is fit to be rejected.

From perusal of LCR and case diary it transpires that petitioner is named accused in the FIR. The allegation against him is of establishing physical relation with informant on the pretext of marriage and also made her video with the help of his other associates, demanded Rs.2 lakh also.

In the above facts, circumstances and also considering the fact that the accused/petitioner is named accused in the FIR and there is specific allegation against him of establishing physical relationship with the informant Chandani Kumari and he alongwith other accused persons came and committed physical relationship and made videography of the same and threatened to make viral the video. The allegation against accused/petitioner is heinous in nature. Hence, I am

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not inclined to enlarge the accused/petitioner on regular bail hence his regular bail application is hereby rejected.
