ORDER

19.06.2026 The petitioner named above is in custody since 12.08.2025 in connection with Industrial Area PS Case no.-94/2024, u/s 105, 125(b) of BNS and Section 9 of Bihar control of the use and play of Loudspeaker Act, 1955 and hence the instant petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on his behalf.

The prosecution case in short is that on 4th Day of August 2024 at Vill-Sultanpur, District-Vaishali due to alleged negligence of the petitioner in fixing tall bamboo poles on a DJ Vehicle, the trolley came in contact with an 11,000/- volt high tension wire, causing the death of nine persons namely Chandan Kumar, Ravi Paswan, Raja Kumar, Amod Paswan, Navin Kumar, Naumi Kumar, Suman Kumar, Aashish Kumar, Aashik Kumar and injuries to others.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is further submitted that petitioner is in jail custody since 12.08.2025. It is further submitted that petitioner has no criminal antecedent against his name and is ready to furnish adequate bail bond and sureties to the

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satisfaction of the court. It is therefore prayed to reject the bail application of accused/petitioner.

Ld. App opposed the petition and submitted that due to negligence of accused/petitioner nine persons died and others sustained injury. It is therefore prayed to reject the bail application of accused/petitioner.

Heard the parties and perused the LCR. From perusal of record it transpires that the allegation against accused/petitioner is that he had fixed tall bamboo poles on a DJ Vehicle, which came in contact with 11,000/- volt high tension wire, causing the death of nine persons namely Chandan Kumar, Ravi Paswan, Raja Kumar, Amod Paswan, Navin Kumar, Naumi Kumar, Suman Kumar, Aashish Kumar, Aashik Kumar and injuries to others. In para 2 of the case diary there is seizure list memo in which the alleged vehicle, trolley and music systems etc. were recovered. In para 3 there is restatement of the informant and in para 4, 5, 6, 7, 13 & 14 are the statements of witnesses who have supported the prosecution case. The witnesses in their respective statements have stated that the petitioner was tying the bamboo for more than 15 feet height and when they opposed for the same, the petitioner ignoring the suggestion given by the locals tied the bamboo on such height and hence this incidence occurred. In para 22 is the inquest reports of deceased persons is given. In para 25 there is supervision report in which prosecution has made its story true. In para 88 there is mentioning that the owner of the said vehicle is Pramod Paswan who is the father of the petitioner and vehicle is used by the petitioner. In para 44 there is mentioning of post mortem reports of the deceased persons in which cause of death is given as " Cardiac Asystole following electrocution".

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Earlier also the bail application of accused/petitioner was rejected by this court vide BP no. 1296/2025 and by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Crl. Misc Case no. 72855 of 2025. In the above facts, circumstances of the case and considering the gravity of offence I am not inclined to enlarge the accused/petitioner on regular bail and hence the bail application so filed on his behalf is hereby rejected.
