ORDER

09.04.2026 The petitioners above named are in custody since 18.02.2026
in connection with Vaishali PS Case no.-123/2026 and hence the instant

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petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on their behalf. The above named petitioners have filed the petitions for grant of regular bail in three sets, however, since both the matter relates to the same PS case therefore, for the purpose of convenience the adjudication on the petitions is being made together.

The prosecution case in short is that on 16.02.2026 at about 13:00 hrs sub-inspector namely Jai Jai Ram Paswan presently posted at Vaishali PS received a secret information that owner and operator of Abhishek Vaishali Hotel and The Royal Cafe and Restaurant are running business of prostitution by bringing girls from outside, who can be caught on search. The further prosecution case is that raid was conducted by surrounding hotel and getting them videographed one by one. During raid of the hotel of which the manager name is Ravindra Baitha, Victim girls were rescued and Niraj Kumar, Mahesh Mahto, Sahul Kumar and Mukesh Sahni were found in suspicious condition. On search and seizure several mobile phones, condoms, register were recovered. Accordingly, all accused persons were arrested. Thereafter raid was conducted at The Royal Cafe and Restaurant in which hotel manager is Dhiraj Kumar Rai, Jagarnath Rai @ Jagga, Amresh Sahni and on search 2 condoms, visiting card, register and some cash were seized. Accordingly, with the said allegation FIR has been instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent

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and they have committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is further submitted that petitioners are neither owner nor operator of the said hotels. It is further submitted that during course of investigation no any victims laides had taken the name of the petitioners and police implicated the petitioners only with a view to show their raid successful. It is further submitted that petitioners are man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence and they are ready to abide all such conditions which will be imposed. It is therefore prayed that petitioners be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and submitted that the accused/petitioners are named in the FIR and there is specific allegation against them is that they were found in suspicion condition and they are involved in prostitution. As such the bail application of accused/petitioners are fit to be rejected.

Heard the parties and perused the record. On perusal of LCR and Case diary it transpires that the accused/petitioners are named in the FIR and the allegation against them is that they were involved in prostitution and found in suspicion condition when police arrested them. The informant in his re-statement in para 3 and other witnesses in para 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the case diary have supported the prosecution case. In para 9 of the case diary seizure list is mentioned in which police has recovered several phones, condoms, visiting card,

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register and some cash. The investigation is going on. Hence I am not inclined to admit accused/petitioners on regular bail. Accordingly, the prayers for regular bail of the accused/petitioners is hereby rejected.
