Order

09.03.2026 The instant petition has been filed praying to extend the date of surrender of accused/petitioners of the order dated 06.02.2026 passed in ABP no.2515/2025 whereby the petitioners therein were allowed the privilege of anticipatory bail by this court. The petitioners pray modification of the aforesaid order to the extent that the period so allowed therein for surrender of accused persons be extended so that to allow the petitioners to surrender before learned court below after the period so stipulated therein for surrender.

The learned counsel for petitioners submitted that petitioners were granted bail by this court on 06.02.2026 in ABP no. 2515/2025. In the said order they were directed to surrender in the court below within 15 days. Unfortunately due to illness of learned

counsel on behalf of petitioners namely Mr. Rakesh Kumar they could not surrender before the learned court below during the stipulated time. Now the petitioners are ready to surrender in the court below. The petitioners lawyer has finally submitted that the stipulated period of 15 days may be extended and the petitioners may be allowed surrender in the court below and filed their bail bond.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition.

Heard the parties and perused the record. From the perusal of record it transpires that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail on 06.02.2026 vide ABP no. 2515/2025 with direction to enlarge on bail in the event of arrest or surrender within 15 days from this order. The learned lawyer was ill as such the accused/petitioners did not surrender within stipulated time. Considering the submissions made by defence counsel the time period to surrender and furnishing the bail bond of the petitioners is extended to 15 days more from the receipts of this order to the trial court. Accordingly this criminal miscellaneous petition is hereby allowed.
