To prevent delay, issues are being on the basis of pleadings on record.

Pleadings are complete. From the pleadings of the parties, following issues are framed:-

(1) Whether the petitioner Ravi Kumar suffered injuries in an accident that took place on 27.09.2025, at about 02.00 p.m., involving vehicle bearing registration No. DL-01LAA-4401, owned and driven by the Respondent No. 1 rashly and negligently and insured with the respondent no. 2? OPP.

(2) Whether the petitioner is entitled for compensation? If so, to what amount and from whom?OPP

(3) Relief.

Renotify for PE on **16.09.2026**.

Evidence by way of affidavit along with list of witnesses be filed by the petitioner within four weeks from today with advance copy to the opposite side. Petitioner is at liberty to take steps for summoning of formal witnesses, if any, within four weeks prior to the NDOH.

Since no disability assessment report has been received, a request letter be issued to the M.S. concerned, Hindu Rao Hospital to file the report in terms of order dated 01.06.2026 at the earliest.
