The petitioner above named is in custody since 04.11.2023 in connection with Desari PS Case no. 371/2023, u/s 302/34 of IPC and hence instant petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on his behalf.

Heard the learned lawyer for the accused/petitioner as well as Learned APP on behalf of state.

The prosecution case in short is that the informant has alleged that 03-11-2023 at 06:30 when the son of the informant washing his teeth on out-house. Meanwhile, accused Dinesh Prasad Singh, Ashwani Singh, Suresh Prasad Singh, Ajit Kumar Singh, wife of Suresh Prasad and wife of Ajit Prasad on having deadly weapon in their hand and unlawful assembly. Dinesh Prasad Singh having gun in his hand, Ashwani Prasad Singh carrying pistol in his hand and others carrying sticks. On order of Suresh Prasad Singh, Dinesh Prasad Singh fire upon Vikram Prasad Singh caused injury on his chest, he fall down, on which other accused assaulted him by lathi and danda. When informant come for rescue she also assaulted by

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allaccused. The Vikram Kumar Singh died. Accordingly, with the said allegation FIR has been instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that regular bail of the petitioner has been refused by learned Sessions Judge as well as by the Hon'ble Court vide Crl. Misc no. 24671/2024 on 19.04.2024 and the once more it was withdrawn on 01.08.2025 vide Crl. Misc Case no. 31845/2025 and except this he has not moved any other bail application. It is further submitted that petitioner renews his prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner has been suffering from acute pile problem which has developed into carcinoma. It is further submitted that petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of the court. It is therefore prayed that petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and submitted that the accused/petitioner is named in the FIR and allegation against him is of committing murder of son of informant which is heinous in nature. As such the bail application of accused/petitioner is fit to be rejected.

From perusal of record it transpires that the allegation against petitioner is that he has committed that murder of son of informant.

In the above facts, circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that there is direct allegation to fire against accused/petitioner Dinesh Prasad Singh due to which the son of informant died on the way to hospital. The allegation against accused/petitioner is heinous in nature. The bail application of accused/petitioner has already been rejected upto Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Crl. Misc Case no.24671/2024, dated 19.04.2024. Hence, I am of the opinion that it is not a fit case to admit the accused/petitioner to regular bail and accordingly

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his prayer for bail is hereby rejected.
