Heard the learned defence counsel as well as learned Public Prosecutor on the anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioners under section 482 of B.N.S.S. who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bidupur P.S. Case No. 808/2024 registered u/ss. 115(2), 126(2), 329(3), 74, 109, 352, 351(3) & 3(5) of B.N.S

It is stated in Para 2 of the anticipatory bail petition that no bail application either anticipatory or regular has been filed in the present case either before this court of Sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

The case of the prosecution in brief, as per written report of the informant Danyal Ahmad is that on 21.11.2024 all the accused persons as named in the F.I.R. including the petitioners came at the door of informant armed with lathi-danda, iron rod and started abusing. When the informant protested, accused Belal Khan @ Guriya assaulted with iron rod causing head injury. Thereafter Md. Imran assaulted with danda. When the female inmates of the house came to save, they also assaulted them and entered in to the house and damaged the house

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hold articles and caused loss of Rs. 2 lakhs.. Nehal Khan has taken away a box containing ornaments etc. worth Rs. 5 lakhs. They also threatened of dire consequences.

The learned counsel for the above named accused petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. The entire allegations are false and concocted. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Case has been compromised between the parties. The co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide A.B.P. No. 969/2025. Hence, prayer has been made for anticipatory bail,

The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard both the parties. Perused the trial court record and the case diary. From perusal of the trial court record and the case diary as well as materials available on the record, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against petitioners to assault the informant. The original and supplementary injury report of injured/informant mentioned in Para 33 of the case diary shows that the informant has sustained single injury which is :-

Stitched wound on forehead 3" in length. As per C.T. Scan report, the said injury is simple in nature, caused by hard and blunt substance.

From the trial court record, it appears that the co-accused Md. Shakib, Wokil Khan, Md. Sameer, Saddam Khan, Ataul Khan, Danish Khan @ Azad Khan and Md. Imran @ Md. Rabnawaj have already been granted anticipatory bail by

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the predecessor of this court vide order dated 22.05.2025 passed in A.B.P. No. 969/2025.

Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as nature of the allegations, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the above named accused petitioners is hereby allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender, they will be enlarged on anticipatory bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below within four weeks of this order, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023.
