Order

1. The anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner-, **(1) Pappu Chaudhary @ Pappu Yadav, (2) Bebi Devi, (3) Premila Devi, (4) Bhagwan Chaudhary @ Bhagwan Yadav, (5) Renuka Devi, (6) Ajeet Chaudhary @ Ajeet Kumar Chaudhary, (7) Bhulli Devi** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with aforesaid case, **Jandaha P.S. Case No. 176/2026, U/s – 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 324(4), 303(2), 351(2), 109, 352, 3(5) B.N.S.**

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioners pressed the anticipatory bail petition and submitted that, no prayer either for anticipatory or regular bail have been moved on behalf of the petitioners before this Ld. Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. That, the petitioners got

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no criminal antecedent. That, the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. That, no occurrence as alleged took place ever since and entire story is creation of mind of the informant. That, more over the real fact is that the informant Bibesh Kumar occur accident and on same protest the informant lodged the false case. That, it is further submitted that the present case is counter blast of Jandaha P.S. Case No. 177/2026, lodged by the petitioner no.1 Pappu Chaudhary @ Pappu Yadav and the present case lodged due to compromise the case under pressure tactics. That, the petitioners are law abiding citizen having every respect and regard for the law of the land and they are apprehending their arrest at the hands of the local police in connection with the present case. That, the petitioners are ready to furnish sound bail bond of local bailors to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court.

3. Per contra, Ld. A.P.P. for the State and Ld. Adv. Of Informant have vehemently opposed prayer for anticipatory bail and he filed two photographs and submitted that the accused-petitioners are named in F.I.R., further investigation is still going on.

4. As per written application of Informant-**Bibesh Kumar**, the prosecution's case in short is that, on 29.03.2026 at about 09:00 am, informant was going from his house to Jandaha market to buy goods. AS soon as informant was in front of the house of late Bhagdev Chaudhary, his entire family members stopped his vehicle, armed with weapon and started hitting the vehicle and him. Names of these are (I) Bhagwan Chaudhary, (ii) Pappu Chaudhary, (iii) Ajit Chaudhary, (iv) Sunil Chaudhary @ Pankaj Chaudhary, (v) wife of Bhagwan Chaudhary, (vi) wife of late Bhagdev Chaudhary, (vii) Pramila Devi, (viii) Baby Devi. The accused together started using weapons, in which Bhagwan Chaudhary had a pistol, Ajit Kumar had a sword, Sunil Kumar had an

17.06.2026	iron rod and all the accused were using bricks and stones. Due to which the head was cut, the car was hit and a gold chain and Rs. 1,20,000/- which were in the car and which were going to the market to buy food items were taken away. When the villagers gathered, all the accused ran away. 5. Heard both sides, and perused the available C.D. and materials available on record, as per injury report of informant the nature of injury is simple in nature. As per bail petition para-3 they have no criminal antecedent. 6. Hence, regard being had to above mentioned facts and circumstances, application for anticipatory bail of the above mentioned petitioners are allowed and I direct that, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within fifteen days (15 days) from the date of receipt of copy of this order, petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing their bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld Court below subject to the condition under the provision of Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. 7.
