<u>03.07.2026</u>	<u>Order</u> 1. The regular bail petition of the petitioner-Gaurav Kumar Das, who is in custody since 16.04.2026, in aforesaid case, Ganga Bridge P.S. Case No. 87/2026, U/ss – 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 303(2), 351(2), 3(5) B.N.S. 2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner pressed the regular bail petition and submitted that, earlier no any bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner as anticipatory or regular either before this Court or any other higher Court presently no other bail petition is pending before this Court or Hon'ble High Court or Hon'ble Supreme Court or Court below. That the petitioner had a single case vide Ganga Bridge P.S. Case No. 279/2023, in which he has been acquitted on 26.06.2025 by Juvenile Justice Board, Hajipur Vaishali. That the petitioner is in judicial custody sine 16.04.2026. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has been falsely

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implicated in this case. That no corresponding injuries has been followed by the doctor. That all the offences are bailable in nature except section 303(2) and 109 of B.N.S. which are not applicable but has been added only to make the offence non bailable. That the grand mother Meena Devi of the petitioner Gaurav Kumar Das has also lodged a case vide Ganga Bridge P.S. Case No. 97/2026, U/s 126(2), 115(2), 74, 352, 351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. against the informant and others. That the petitioner is man of means and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the satisfaction of the Ld. Lower Court.

3. The Ld. A.P.P. and Ld. Adv. Of the Informant vehemently opposed the regular bail petition, and submitted that the petitioner is named in the FIR, further investigation is still going on.

4. As per fard-bayan of the informant-**Raj Kumar Das**, the prosecution's case in short is that, on 28.03.2026 at about 08:00 in the morning, Informant and his father were sitting at their door, at that time (1) Gaurav Kr. Das, (2) Ritik Kr. Das, were passing in front of his door saying filthy things. His father Nandlas Das said to both the boys that you keep coming and going from my door and saying filthy things, why do you do this. On this, both the boys started abusing his father and said that if you say too much, we will kill you. Then informant said that when father explains to you, you abused instead. AT that very moment, both the boys grabbed him and started beating him. When Informant started shouting, Gaurav kumar took out a knife from his pocket and stabbed him on the head with the intention of killing him. When informant stepped back to save himself, the knife hit his left hand, cutting it. It started bleeding profusely, and he sat down injured. Seeing this, when his son Ajay Kumar, came to rescue, Ritik Das took out a knife from his pocket and stabbed his

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son. Ajay Kumar, in the stomach and also stabbed him in the hand with the intention of killing him. When the commotion began, both of them started running away. During the escape, Gaurav Kumar Das snatched a gold Hanumani idol worth 55,000/- rupees from his neck. Then dialed 112 at Gangabridge, and police arrived at the scene. With the help of locals, Informant was brought to Sadar Hospital, Hajipur, where informant and his son Ajay Kumar, are under treatment.

5. Heard both the parties. Perused the C.D., the accused-petitioner is in custody since 16.04.2026. In C.D. Para-34 injury report of both injured persons Raj Kumar Das and Ajay Kumar is mentioned, according to this report the nature of injury of both injured persons are simple in nature. Further investigation is still going on.

6. Hence, in the light of above said, I am inclined to grant privilege of regular bail to this accused petitioner, the same is hereby, **allowed**. It is ordered that accused-petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing of bail bond Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below.
