1. Heard, all the regular bail petitions of accused/petitioners filed separately but heard together since all are arising out of same P.S. **Raghopur P.S. Case No. 69/2026**, U/ss – 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 74, 352, 351(2), 351(4), 3(5) of B.N.S.

2. These petitions for regular bail has been filed on the behalf of the accused namely, **(1) Shivnath Rai, (2) Rizintu Kumar, (3) Bipin Kumar, (4) Pappu Rai, (5) Kanchan Rai, (6) Chanchal Rai, (7) Pintu Kumar** who are in custody since 09.04.2026, 18.04.2026 & 19.05.2026, respectively in connection with aforesaid case, pending in Ld. Court below.

3. Learned Adv. On behalf of the petitioners pressed the regular bail petitions and submitted that, earlier the petitioners have not filed any type of bail application either before this Ld. Court or before any other competent Court of law. That, before lodging of this case one case as Raghopur P.S. Case No.- 68/26, U/Ss 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 351(4), 3(5) of the B.N.S.-2023 lodged against the petitioners same occurrence and same date & time by Bimal Kumar except this no criminal bad antecedent. That the petitioners are quite innocent, have not committed any offence and petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case due to previous dispute. That, the present case is false and concocted and the present case lodged against the petitioner by way of defence of Raghopur P.S. Case No. 67/26, filed by daughter of petitioner no.1 against the informant and his mates. That, matter of fact is that the business of his mate is of liquor regarding which the police keep raiding continuously every day and the informant said that it is the petitioner who harass as by giving information to the police and that is why they beaten up the petitioner and failed a false case. That the petitioner and informant are own pattidar and they live in same

That, no case is made out U/s-109 of the B.N.S. rather after reading the entire FIR there is no intention and no repetition is reflected from perusal of injury report all injury is simple in nature caused by hard blunt like lathi. That, no specific allegation against the petitioner and all offences are general in nature. That, the petitioners are ready to furnish sound and suitable sureties to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court. 4. Per contra, Ld. A.P.P. for the State and Ld. Adv. Of Informant have vehemently opposed prayer for regular bail and said that the accused-petitioners are named in the F.I.R. 5. On the basis of written application of Informant-Priyanka Kumari, the prosecution's case is in short is that on 15.02.2026, Informant was sitting on his door, when suddenly (1) Chanchal Rai, (2) Kanchan Rai, (3) Shivnath Rai, (4) Pappu Rai, (5) Rizintu Kumar, (6) Pintu Kumar, (7) Vipin Kumar, came to her house and started abusing her and kicking and beating her. Chanchal Rai hit her on the head with an iron rod in his hand, due to which blood started flowing. When informant sister-in-law Lakshmi Devi, brother Rahul Kumar, Rohit Kumar came to her rescue, the said people also beat them and injured them. When the people nearby came to her after hearing the noise, the said people started running away and while running away, Rizintu Kumar snatched a gold chain from her neck. 6. Heard, both sides and perused the L.C.R. and available case diary the accused-petitioners are in custody since 09.04.2026, 18.04.2026 & 19.05.2026, respectively. In C.D. Para-29 injury report of Priyanka Kumari is mentioned, according to this report the nature of injury is simple in nature. In C.D. Para-30 injury report of Laxmi Devi is mentioned, according to this report the nature of injury is simple in

Para-31 injury report of Rohit Kumar is mentioned, according to this report the nature of injury is simple in nature. In C.D. Para-107 injury report of Rahul Kumar is mentioned, and separately attached with C.D., according to this report the nature of injury is simple in nature. After investigation police submitted the charge-sheet. 7. Hence, regard being had of above mentioned facts and circumstances, I am inclined to grant privilege of bail to these accused petitioners, the same is hereby allowed. It is ordered that accused-petitioners be enlarged on bail on furnishing of bail bond Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld.
