Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned P.P. appearing on the behalf of the State.

The Counsel for the petitioner submitted that Sessions Trial No. 402 of 2025 arising out of Raghapur PS case number 161 of 2023 is pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge -8 in which the petitioner is accused and Sessions Trial No. 797 of 2025 arising out of Raghapur PS case number 112 of 2023 in which petitioner is informant which is pending in the Court of Addl. Sessions Judge -10, are counter cases as such they should be tried by same Court.

As such in the interest of justice, Sessions Trial No. 402 of 2025 in which petitioner is accused could be transferred to court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-10 from the court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge -8, Vaishali.

Hence, Sessions Trial No. 402 of 2025 is transferred to the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge -10 and the learned Additional Sessions Judge-10, Vaishali is requested to proceed in both the sessions case as per law.

Accordingly, this Cr. Misc. Petition stands disposed of.
