Order

1. The anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner-**Afsari Praveen**, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with aforesaid case, **Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 277/2026**, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 109, 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S.

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner pressed the anticipatory bail petition and submitted that, earlier no bail petition anticipatory or regular has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before your honour's Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. That the petitioner has not no bad antecedent. That on the basis of written petition of the informant the above noted case has been registered. That, the petitioner is innocent and did not commit any offence. That, earlier prosecution story as alleged by the informant is false and concocted and no occurrence did take place as alleged. That, a matter of fact the installment is being paid regularly by the petitioner and the informant has not furnished the money receipt to the petitioner and when the petitioner demanded money receipt from the informant the informant abused her and threatened her to file case.

<u>29.06.2026</u>	So, the informant filed this false case only with a view to realise excess money from the petitioner. That, the informant has not received any injury. So, no case U/s 109, 118(1) of B.N.S. is made out and all other sections are bailable in nature. That, the petitioner is a pardanasin lady and ready to co-operate in investigation. That, the petitioner is ready to abide by all the conditions as laid down U/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S./438(2) of Cr. P.C. That the petitioner is ready to furnish sound and local bailors. 3. The Ld. A.P.P. vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition, and submitted that the petitioner is named in the FIR, further investigation is still going on. 4. As per written application of the informant-Ritik Kumar Singh, the prosecution's case in short is that, Informant is a Bajaj Finance Collection Manager, on 25.03.26 from his office Anwarpur, informant called a customer, Afsari Praveen, who had financed a mobile phone on low installment on 30.10.25. The price of the mobile phone was Rs. 10,999/-. She deposited the installment for two months, after that she did not pay. That day when Informant went to Afsari Praveen's house to collect the instalment (i) Afsari Praveen, (ii) Afsari Praveen's elder son, name not known, started abusing him. When informant refused to abuse and asked her to pay the installment. Afsari Praveen heat him from stick, and her elder son came with an iron rod and hit him on the head with the intention of killing him, due to which lot of blood started flowing and informant fell down. Afsari Praveen's husband Md. Saukat took Rs. 24,300 from his pocket and a gold Hanumani worth Rs. 55,000/-. When the commotion broke out, passerby gathered, and everyone fled. Informant called his friend, they brought him to Sadar Hospital, where he received treatment.
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<u>29.06.2026</u>	5. Heard both the parties. Perused C.D., in C.D. Para-14 criminal history of accused-petitioner is mentioned, she has no criminal antecedent. In C.D. Para-18 injury report of informant is mentioned and separately attached with C.D., according to this report the nature of injury is simple in nature. 6. Hence, regard being had to above mentioned facts and circumstances, application for anticipatory bail of the above mentioned petitioner is allowed and I direct that, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within fifteen days (15 days) from the date of receipt of copy of this order, petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing his bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld Court below subject to the condition under the provision of Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. 7.
