Order

1. The regular bail petition of the petitioner-**Indrajit Kumar @ Chotu**, who is in custody since 28.03.2026, in aforesaid case, **Patepur P.S. Case No. 291/2025, U/ss – 308(4), 3(5) B.N.S.**

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner pressed the regular bail petition and submitted that, no petition for anticipatory or regular bail on behalf of the petitioner has been previously to this case. That the petitioner has the following criminal antecedents: (i) Patepur P.S. Case No. 218/23, (ii) Patepur P.S. Case No. 273/25, (iii) Baligaon P.S. Case No. 159/24. That the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 28.03.2026. That the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence whatsoever. That the prosecution's story is false, concocted and baseless. That the petitioner categorically denies all allegations made by the prosecution. That the present F.I.R. is not based on actual facts; the petitioner never made any extortion demand to the informant. That the petitioner has no role or involvement in the alleged occurrence but has been falsely implicated due to the influence of enemies. That the petitioner has no concern or connection

14.07.2026	with the mobile phone or number mentioned in the allegations. That there is no bonafide evidence against the petitioner to support the charge of extortion. That as per the F.I.R. no case under the BNSS is acutally made out against the petitioner. That the petitioner previously prayed for bail before the Court of ACJM-13, but the prayer was rejected. That the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions imposed by this Hon'ble Court and there is no chance of him absconding or tampering with evidence. That the petitioner is a man of means and is ready to furnish sound and suitable bailors to the satisfaction of the Hon'ble Court. 3. The Ld. A.P.P. opposed the regular bail petition, and submitted that the petitioner is named in the FIR and after investigation chargesheet has been submitted. 4. As per written application of the informant-Uttam Kumar, the prosecution's case in short is that, informant currently run his paan shop next to Bharat Petrol Pump, Patepur. On 01.09.2025, accused Indrajit Kumar @ Chotu, through phone of Manish Kumar @ Bucchi, demanded Rs. 2,50,000/- as extortion money and threatened to kill him if the amount was not paid. The accused also threatened to falsely implicate the complainant in a criminal case by claiming that he had instigated on the S.H.O. on 02.09.2025, the accused again contacted the complainant through whatsapp messages, calls and a voice recording from mobile number 8873730765, reiterating the demand and threatending to shoot him at his shop if the money was not paid within an hour. The complainant states that he is living in fear, alleges that the accused is a habitual criminal with several criminal cases, and has submitted the audio recording on a pen drive along with the complaint. Accordingly, the complainant seeks registration of an FIR
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14.07.2026	against Indrajit Kumar @ Chotu and Manish Kumar @ Bucchi, along with appropriate legal action and protection of his life and property. 5. Heard both the parties. Perused the L.C.R., C.D. and supplementary C.D., the accused-petitioner is in custody since 28.03.2026, cognizance of the offence has been taken by Ld. A.C.J.M.- XIII against co-accused of this case. Earlier co-accused Manish Kumar @ Bucchi of this case has been granted bail by Ld. A.C.J.M.-XIII, vide order dt. 20.01.2026. After investigation police has been submitted chargesheet against this petitioner. 6. Hence, in the light of above said, I am inclined to grant privilege of regular bail to this accused petitioner, the same is hereby, allowed. It is ordered that accused-petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing of bail bond Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Subject to filing of undertaking about his criminal antecedent and that he will fully co-operate in trial. 7. O/C will send the copy of this order along with L.C.R. to concerned Ld.
