Order

1. The anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner-**Arun Mahto**, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with aforesaid case, **Lalganj P.S. Case No. 414/2024, U/ss – 333, 115(2), 303(2), 75, 352, 351(3) B.N.S.**

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner pressed the anticipatory bail petition and submitted that the petitioner has not moved this Court or Hon'ble High Court earlier either for regular or anticipatory bail. That the petitioner has no bad antecedent. That the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this instant case and no occurrence have ever been took place as alleged on F.I.R. That as a matter of fact petitioner has a son who is mentally disorder and informant and petitioners are their pattidar of each other and family dispute are going between them, therefore, the informant lodged this false case against the petitioner. That the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. That the petitioner has apprehension of arrest at the hands of police, therefore, he filed this petition. That

<p><u>25.03.2026</u></p>	<p>the petitioners are ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of the Court and abide by this rules enunciated U/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.</p> <p>3. The Ld. A.P.P. and Ld. Adv. Of Informant vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition, and submitted that the petitioner is the named in F.I.R., and further investigation is still going on.</p> <p>4. As per fard-bayan of the informant-Babita Devi, the prosecution's case in short is that on 29.10.2024, at 7:00 am, she was at the door of the house when Arun Mahto, S/o: Jangli Mahato, after drinking, teases her without any reason in the house and keeps on bothering her. When she was asleep at night. He entered informant's house and started abusing her and when she refused, he beat her with a stick, injured her and snatched the gold mangalsutra worth Rs. 15,000/- from her neck and tore her clothes and tied her up. He is informant's husband elder brother (Bhaisur) but he looks at her with bad intentions and keeps harassing her by saying bad things. He threatened that if informant do anything, he will kill her.</p> <p>5. Heard both the parties. Perused the C.D. and materials available on record. In C.D. Para- 16 it is mentioned that when police investigate the medical injury report of Babita Devi in Hospital Lalganj, he found that there is no medical injury registered in Hospital register, patient was treated in emergency without any information of assault. In C.D. Para-19 it is mentioned that there is no any criminal antecedent against this accused-petitioner. Further investigation is still going on.</p>

Hence, regard being had to above mentioned facts and circumstances, application for anticipatory bail of the above mentioned petitioner is allowed and I direct that, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within fifteen days (15 days) from the date of receipt of copy of this order, petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing his bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two surities of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld Court below subject to the condition under the provision of Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.</p> <p>7.
