Order

1. The regular bail petition of the petitioner-**Rajan Kumar**, who is in custody since 17.02.2025 in **Kartahan P.S. Case No. 10/2025, U/s – 331(4), 305 of B.N.S.**

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner pressed the regular bail petition and submitted that, no other bail petition has been moved in this Court or any other superior Court either regular or anticipatory. That there is seven bad criminal antecedent against the petitioner as follow (i) Kartaha P.S. Case No. 144/24, (ii) Kartaha P.S. Case No. 13/25, (iii) Kartaha P.S. Case No. 15/25, (iv) Kartaha P.S. Case No. 17/25, (v) Lalganj P.S. Case No. 27/25, (vi) Lalganj P.S. Case No. 32/25, (vii) Lalganj P.S. Case No. 488/24. Other than no any bad antecedent against the petitioner. That the petitioner is in judicial custody since 17.02.2025. That the F.I.R. filed by informant Nutan Devi is unknown. That the petitioner name is not mention in the F.I.R. directly or indirectly. That the petitioner is quite innocent and did

30.06.2026	not involved in this action as alleged in F.I.R. That the petitioner is man of means and ready to furnish personal bond to the satisfaction of the Court. 3. Per contra, Ld. A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed prayer for regular bail, after investigation police submitted the charge-sheet. 4. As per written application of Informant-Nutan Devi, the prosecution's case in short is that, Informant and her family members have been living at her Mahua residence for the past 10 days. During this time, her house was burgled on the night of 09.01.2025. Informant received information about this from her neighbours on 10.01.2025 at 09:15 am. Through a phone call that the lock of the gate has been cut. Informant hurriedly reached her residence at 10:30 am. And saw that the godrej cupboard of her room was opened and the cash of Rs. 40,000/- and gold and silver jewellery kept in it which included chain, an earring and three pieces of ring weighing 38 grms and it was of gold and three pairs of silver anklets weighing 250 grms. Were missing. She has fully confident that this was stolen by some unknown thieves. 5. Heard both sides, and perused the L.C.R., along with C.D., the accused-petitioner is in custody since 17.02.2025, charges have already been framed. Earlier co-accused of this case has been granted bail by Ld. Predecessor Court vide B.P. No. 794 of 2025. order dt. 10.06.2025. This bail petition stands on similar footing.

6. Hence, in the light of above said, I am inclined to grant privilege of regular bail to this accused petitioner, the same is hereby, **allowed**. It is ordered that accused-petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing of bail bond Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with one sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. **Subject to filing of undertaking about his criminal antecedent and that he will fully co-operate in trial.**
