The regular bail petition of the above named accused petitioner has been filed u/s 483 of B.N.S.S., who is in judicial custody since 23.04.2026 in connection with Vaishali P.S. Case No. 290/2026 for the offences u/ss.126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2) & 3(5) of B.N.S..

Heard the learned counsel for the accused petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor for the State and perused the record.

It is stated in Para 2 of the bail petition that earlier no bail application either anticipatory or regular has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this court of sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

The case of the prosecution in brief, as per written report of the informant Chandradeo Rai is that on 19.04.2026 his grand son Amit Kumar had gone to temple near the house, where the accused persons namely Akash Kumar, Anshu Kumar @ Suman and Raj Kumar Paswan started abusing. When his grand son protested, they started assaulting with lathi, danda, rod. Akash Kumar assaulted with Balla and Anshu Kumar assaulted with knife, due to which his grand son sustained cut injury on his cheek and head. They also snatched gold chain from his neck and Rs.500/- from his pocket. The local people pacified the matter. It is further alleged that when the informant alongwith his

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grand son went to the father of Akash namely Raj Kumar Paswan, Raj Kumar Paswan told that he will kill them and implicate in a case of SC/ST Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. The entire allegation is false and concocted. No occurrence as alleged took place. No case u/s 109 B.N.S. is made out against the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The accused petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.04.2026. On these basis, prayer has been made to release the petitioner accused on bail.

Learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard the parties. Perused the record and the case diary. From perusal of the record and the case diary, it transpires that there is allegation against the petitioner to assault the informant's grand son by knife.

The injury report of injured Amit Kumar shows that he has sustained :-

1. cut injury fore head,
- 2.Body pain and headache.

No dimension of of injury no.1 was mentioned in the injury report. The said injuries are simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.04.2026 and he has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in Para 3 of the bail petition..

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Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as nature of allegations and the period of custody, the regular bail petition of the petitioner is allowed. Accordingly, the above named accused petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
