The regular bail petition of the above named accused petitioner has been filed u/s 483 of B.N.S.S., who is in judicial custody since 25.04.2026 in connection with Kartaha P.S. Case No. 01/2026 for the offences u/ss. 115(2), 126(2), 352, 109, 3(5) of B.N.S. and sections 25(1-b)a, 27 & 35 of Arms Act.

Heard the learned counsel for the accused petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor for the State and perused the record.

It is stated in Para 2 of the bail petition that earlier no bail application either anticipatory or regular has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this court of sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

The prosecution case in brief, as per fardbahan of the informant Virendra Kumar Rai is that on 31.12.2025 at about 7 P.M. when he came out of his house, then he saw that his elder son Prianshu Kumar @ Chunnu Kumar and Niraj were scuffling. Upon being inquired, his son stated that Neeraj had come with intention to kill him. It is further alleged that co-accused Shahil took out a cartridge from the pocket of Neeraj Kumar and gave cartridge to his son Priyanshu Kumar. Thereafter police of 112 came and the cartridge has been handed over to the police. After some times the some people came on 4-5 motorcycles and started firing at his door and also abused. One of them was **Manish**.

The learned counsel for the above named accused petitioner submits that the accused petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been

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implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from his possession. Petitioner has criminal antecedent of one other criminal case. The co-accused Neeraj Kumar has been granted regular bail by this court vide B.P. No.87/2026. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.04.2026. On these basis, prayer has been made to release the petitioner accused on bail.

Learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard the parties. Perused the trial court record and the case diary. From perusal of the trial court record and the case diary, it transpires that there is allegation against the petitioner of scuffling with the informant's son. The production cum seizure list shows that from the place of occurrence two live cartridge and four empty cartridges were seized. Petitioner has criminal antecedent of one other criminal case as mentioned in Para 3 of the bail petition. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.04.2026. The co-accused Neeraj Kumar has already been granted regular bail by this court vide B.P. No.87/2026 and the case of the petitioner stands on same and similar footing.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as nature of allegations and the period of custody, the regular bail petition of the petitioner is allowed. Accordingly, the above named accused petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
