Order

1. The anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner-**Lalan Kumar Ray**, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with aforesaid case, **Raghopur P.S. Case No. 77/2026**, U/ss – 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2), 109, 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 303(2), 324(4) of B.N.S.

2. The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner pressed the anticipatory bail petition and submitted that, the petitioner has not moved earlier either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Ld. Court or before Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna. That three cases are pending against the petitioner and which in the petitioner is already on bail and there is no other criminal or bad antecedent against the petitioner. That, the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. The entire prosecution case is wrong, false and concocted and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to village group politics and land dispute and taking same day occurrence Munakiya Devi the mother of the informant filed a case as Raghopur P.S. Case No. 81/2026

<u>22.06.2026</u>	against the petitioner and other co-accused persons. That the allegation against the petitioner is general and omnibus that there is no nay specific allegation against the petitioner. That, no case U/s 109 and 303(2) of the B.N.S.- 23 are made out against this petitioner. That the petitioner has got no any intention to murder of the informant and others and no any injury is available on the body of the vital part of the informant and others. That, the other co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by the Ld. District and Addl. Sessions Judge No. IIIrd, Vaishali at Hajipur vide A.B.P. No. 694/2026 and other dt. 18.03.2026 and the case of this petitioner is stands on similar footing. That the petitioner apprehends he will be arrested by the police in non-bailable offence. That, the petitioner is man of means and has deep roots in the society and if he is enlarged on bail, thee would be neither chance of his absconding nor tampering with the evidence. That, the petitioner is ready to furnish sound bail bond of good bailors and sureties and further ready to abide all the terms and conditions as laid down U/s 482(2) of the B.N.S.S. to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court. 3. The Ld. A.P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail petition, and submitted that the accused-petitioner is named in the F.I.R., further investigation is still going on. 4. As per written application of the informant-Santosh Kumar, the prosecution's case in short is that, on 20.02.2026 informant had appointed a government Amin for measuring of his land, in which the land was being measuring, then (i) Mishri Rai, (ii) Lalan Rai, (iii) Viraju Kumar, (iv) Deepak Kumar, (v) Rahul Kumar, (vi)
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<u>22.06.2026</u>	Sanjeet Kumar, all these people, during the measurement, pulled the tape of the government Amin and threw it away and started fighting with the members of his family and his scorpio car, which was parked in the garage at his house, was broken into the gate of the car and Deepak Kumar took away Rs. 29,500/- kept in the car. When Informant protested against this Lalan Kumar and Virju Kumar Rai started beating him. When his brother Vijay Kumar ran to save him but they started beating him too, in which both brothers got badly injured. After that informant was taken to the police station, after this informant was treated in the hospital. During this his brother was alone at home. These people again entered his house and started firing. Then informant informed the police station and raided the place and recovered a pistol and two live cartridges from Lalan Kumar's house. 5. Heard both the parties. Perused the available C.D., In C.D. Para-15 injury report of Santosh Kumar, Vijay Kumar and Ravindra Rai is mentioned and separately attached with C.D., according to this report the nature of injury of all three injured persons are simple in nature. Earlier co-accused of this has been granted anticipatory bail by Ld. Predecessor Court, vide A.B.P. No. 694/26, order dt. 18.03.2026. Further investigation is still going on 6. Hence, regard being had to above mentioned facts and circumstances, application for anticipatory bail of the above mentioned petitioner is allowed and I direct that, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within fifteen days (15 days) from the date of receipt of copy of this order, petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing his bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-
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<u>22.06.2026</u>	(ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld Court below subject to the condition under the provision of Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. Subject to filing of undertaking about their criminal antecedent and fully co-operate in trial. 7. O/C will send the copy of this order to concerned Ld.
