Heard the learned defence counsel as well as learned Public Prosecutor on the anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioners under section 482 of B.N.S.S. who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No.159/2026 u/ss. 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115, 117(3), 109, 303(2), 74, 352, 351(2) of B.N.S..

It is stated in Para 2 of the anticipatory bail petition that no bail application either anticipatory or regular has been filed in the present case either before this court of Sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

During argument, the learned counsel for the petitioners pressed the petition dated 05.06.2026 and prayed to withdraw the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner no.3 namely Manoj Kumar Thakur due to his arrest. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner no.3 namely Manoj Kumar Thakur **is dismissed** as withdrawn.

The case of the prosecution in brief, as per fardbayan of the informant Santosh Kumar Thakur is that on 22.04.2026 at about 15:00 o'clock he was at his Bathan, at that time all the accused persons as named in the F.I.R. including the

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petitioners armed with lathi, bhala, iron rod, pistol came at his Bathan and started abusing him. When the informant protested, they started assaulting him. It is further alleged that accused **Satyendra Thakur** inflicted iron rod on his head, which hit on his finger of left hand causing fracture injury. Accused **Kislay Kumar** assaulted with butt of pistol on his mouth. Accused **Satyendra Thakur and Kislay Kumar** indiscriminately assaulted with iron rod and accused Manoj Kumar Thakur assaulted with lathi and broke the informant's both leg. Accused Rita Devi and Shilpi Devi started dragging him by wrapping Gamchha around his neck. Accused Punam Devi and Rohit Kumar @ Chhota Babu assaulted with their legs on his chest. When the informant's wife Roji Devi came to save, accused Shilpi Devi and Rita Devi snatched gold chain from her neck. The accused persons also tore Sari of his wife with bad intention.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence. They have falsely been implicated in this case. The entire allegations are false and concocted. No occurrence as alleged took place. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Hence, a prayer has been made to allow this anticipatory bail petition.

The learned Public Prosecutor for the state opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners Satyendra Thakur and Kislay Kumar.

Heard both the parties. Perused the record and the case diary. From perusal of the record and the case diary written up to Para 43 dated 12.06.2026 as well as materials available on record, it transpires that the allegation against the petitioners is that they alongwith other accused persons assaulted the informant and caused injuries to him.

The injury report of injured Santosh Kumar Thakur shows that he has **sustained** :

1. Lacerated wound on left lower limb near about 1 cm long x 0.5 cm width x 0.5 cm depth. Inv. X-ray left tibia and fibula AP Lat.

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2. Pain and swelling on left lower limb. Inv- X-ray left tibia and fibula AP Lat.
3. Lacerated wound on left hand ring finger dorsal side near about 1 cm long x 0.5 cm width x 0.5 depth. Inv – Xray left hand AP Lat.
4. Pain and swelling on left forearm,
5. Pain and swelling on right lower leg. Inv Xray right tibia and febula AP Lat.

The doctor has kept the opinion of injury no.1,2,3 & 5 reserved till x-ray arrives and opined that injury no.4 is simple in nature.

As per supplementary injury report the injury no.1 & 3 are **grievous** and injury no.2,4 & 5 are simple in nature.

From the record, it transpires that there is specific allegation against the accused petitioners Satyendra Thakur and Kislay Kumar to assault the informant by means of iron rod and butt of pistol causing grievous injuries.

Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts, circumstances of the case as well as gravity of the offences, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner no.1 & 2 namely Satyendra Thakur and Kislay Kumar @ Latur Accordingly, their prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby rejected.
