ORDER

13.07.2026 The petitioner named above is in custody since 11.03.2026 in connection with Ganga Bridge PS Case no.-40/2026, u/s 103(1), 238 of BNS and 27 of Arms Act and hence the instant petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on his behalf.

The prosecution case in short is that the informant of this case is Rohit Kumar Sub-Inspector of Ganga Bridge PS. He has alleged that on 19.02.2026 at about 09:30 AM, about 200 meters north of Mahatma Gandhi Setu Western Lane Pillar no. 01, near Gangabridge PS, he record his self typed statement that today on 19.02.2026 in the morning he was sitting in the police station and performing the register work, then at about 07:20 AM, a passerby on a motorcycle who was coming from Patna, came to the police station and informed that a white coloured Alto car with registration no. BR1AE4068 was parked on the road side, a little distance away from Mahatma Gandhi Setu Western Lane pillar no. 01. It's window were closed and inside it seemed that there was a dead body of a person. To this effect FIR no. 0874/26 was registered and after informing the senior officer he reached the spot in the morning and for

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verification of the information and necessary action, he himself along with Sub Inspector and police armed force left the PS for the spot in a police vehicle. When he reached the spot he saw a white coloured Alto car bearing registration no. BR1AF4068(front) and BR1AE4068(back) whose door and glass were closed. On peeping inside the car from outside a person was found lying of the rear seat inside the car. In the presence of other PS officers and armed force on opening the rear door of the car a young man whose age would be around 22 to 27 years was found lying on the seat in a dead state. The information was given to the FSL officer in charge, Hajipur through telephone and the scene was cordoned off and the scene was protected. After receiving the information the FSL Hajipur team reached. On investigation by videography and photography it was found that the dead youth had a small hole in his left arm which appeared to be a bullet wound and there was dried blood coming from the nose of the dead youth and dried blood was found on the left arm of the white shirt he was wearing which was wrapped with a yellow towel. Thereafter, the dead body was taken out of the said vehicle in front of the FSL team. During the investigation the FSL team recovered a cartridge in which 7.62 H & BD inscribed on its bottom and a live cartridge with 7.65KF inscribed on its bottom and the spilled blood and other items were also duly seized by the FSL team. Probably the criminals had murdered the deceased youth at some other place and in order to hide the evidence, they brought the dead body along with the Alto car to pillar no. 01 of Mahatma Gandhi Setu Western lane. Thereafter a formal FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has

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committed no offence. It is further submitted that they have falsely been implicated in this false case on mere suspicion. It is further submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is ready to furnish sound and suitable sureties to the satisfaction of the court. It is therefore prayed that petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and submitted that the allegation against accused/petitioner is that he was one of the member of gang who take contract killing of a politician namely Antu Ishwar and in cross firing one of his gang member namely Bhanu Singh died. The allegation against him is serious in nature. It is therefore prayed to reject the bail petition of accused/petitioner.

Perused the record. From perusal of record it transpires that the allegation against accused/petitioner is that he was one of the member of gang who take contract killing of a politician namely Antu Ishwar and in cross firing one of his gang member namely Bhanu Singh died.

In the above facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that accused/petitioner is that he was one of the member of gang who take contract killing of a politician namely Antu Ishwar and in course of cross firing one of his gang member namely Bhanu Singh sustained bullet injury on his chest and died. The accused/petitioner was arrested and he in his own confessional statement confessed his guilt in which the cause of death of deceased has come. In para 99, 100 of case diary the confessional statement of Ahtesam Aalam @ Lucky Khan and Rahul Yadav @ Chusni has come in which they also confessed their guilt and narrated the same story. The police

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has submitted charge sheet vide CS no. 157/2026, dated 31.05.2026 for the offence u/s 103(1), 238, 61(2) of BNS and 25(1-b)a, 26, 27 of Arms Act. The post-mortem report of deceased has come in para 89 of the case diary wherein the cause of death is due to hemorrhagic and shock due to fire arm injury. The allegation against accused/petitioner is serious in nature. Hence I am not inclined to enlarge the accused/petitioner on regular bail and hence his bail application is hereby rejected.
