ORDER

30.05.2026 The petitioners named above are in custody since 16.04.2026 in connection with Tisiauta PS Case no.-63/2026, u/s 137(2), 96, 3(5) of BNS and hence the instant petition for the grant of regular bail has been filed on their behalf.

The prosecution case in short is that informant of this case Mantosh Kumar Jha, Son of Ramsevak Jha is a permanent resident of Village-Shuhankarpur Tikauli, PS- Tisiauta, Dist-Vaishali. He runs a small grocery shop for his livelihood. On 13.04.2026, he had gone to Hajipur for his personal work. When he returned from Hajipur at around 08:00 PM, he found his shop closed. After this, he went home and asked his wife where is Sanya. His wife said that she is at the shop. He said that the shop is closed. After this, he again went to the shop and

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searched a lot and found out that at the time of closing the shop, Ram Vallabh Pandit, his wife Shanti Devi, Son of Kunal Kumar and two-four unknown people were walking around the shop. He has full suspicion that these people have kidnapped his minor daughter Sanya Kumari, Aged-14 years, with wrong intentions. Any untoward incident can happen to her or she can be sold. Accordingly, with the said allegation FIR has been instituted.

Learned counsel for petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is further submitted that all the allegations are false, fabricated, concocted and baseless. It is further submitted that petitioners were not involved directly or indirectly in alleged occurrence. It is further submitted that the informant and petitioners are co-villagers and informant implicated these petitioners name in this present case due to village dirty politics. It is further submitted that petitioners have not kidnapped the informant's daughter nor torture her. It is further submitted that petitioners are ready to abide by all the terms and conditions which are imposed upon them. It is at last submitted that petitioners will not abscond nor tamper with the prosecution evidence and are ready to furnish sound bail bond of local bailors to the satisfaction of the court. It is therefore prayed that petitioners be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and submitted that the allegation against accused/petitioners is of kidnapping minor daughter of

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informant from his lawful custody. It is therefore prayed to reject the bail petition of accused/petitioners.

Perused the record. From perusal of LCR and Case diary it transpires that the allegation against accused/petitioners is of kidnapping the minor daughter of informant. The informant Mantosh Kumar was running a small shop and he had gone to Hajipur and found his shop and went to his house and inquired from her wife about his daughter, who told that she is at her shop, then he told that shop is closed. He again went and inquired and it was informed that near the shop Ramballabh Pandit alongwith four unknown person were roaming near to shop and her minor daughter Sanya Kumari has been kidnapped. The informant and othr witnesses have stated in their statement that the accused persons were seen roaming near to shop as such believed that they had kidnapped.

In the above facts, circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that in para 52 of the case diary the statement of witness Geeta Devi has been recorded wherein she has said that informant's daughter Sanya Kumari had come to her house without information to anyone and told not to tell to her mother. Her mother had scolded for study. When police visited her house then got information that case of kidnapping has been lodged. The statement of Sanya Kumari has been recorded u/s 183 of BNS in which she has said that on 13.04.2026 she went to the house of her mausi as her mother had scolded for study and she was not been kidnapped. The accused persons are in custody since 16.04.2026. Hence the

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accused/petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on regular bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
